



Race Previews

Raynham-Taunton - 550yd/1650 ft.

ETHEREAL FORCE (7) is the new track record holder, breaking the 15 year standing record in July. Winning 3 of last 4, if he gets out in front, he won't be caught. **BIT OF BEE (5)** won 2 of her last 3, with an 8 length victory last time. **NAUSET LASS (8)** has great early speed. Won 5 of last 6, and 21 total for year. **BACOPA JABBER (6)** is coming back on track. 27 wins this year puts him 2nd only to **ETHEREAL FORCE**. **THINKER (2)**, with 20 wins this year, will be hard to run down if she gets the front. **KELSOS APOLLO (4)** has won 5 of his last 7, and in the super 33 of 42. **TOWNSEND (1)**, only has 12 career starts, but she shows great speed, and has already beaten some in this field. She's made the quiniela 10 of the 12 starts. **IMMORTALIZED (3)** may not look like he belongs here, but this hard-running male is a money maker being in the super 36 of 43.

Seabrook - 550yd/1650 ft.

High early speed is the common denominator in tonight's contest. **COLD B ALKALINE (1)** is the prohibitive favorite here. Winner of the 2004 Great Greyhound Race. She has good rush speed and is well positioned on the rail. **DUTCH MEREDITH (2)** is a seasoned veteran who displays a versatile running style and can fly from on or off the pace. Inside post should suit her well. **FREERIDE YODELL (3)** is a consistent racer at the speedy Seabrook oval. She needs a little luck to upset this stellar field. **MOTOWN HANNAH (4)** must have a perfect trip to place here. 30 of 50 in the trifecta. **HOMETOWN SCOTT (5)** is a veteran who has won his last 7 straight. He will try to parlay his speed and experience into the win. **TNT STAR BOUND (6)** is a rising star who sports an 8 of 9 in the money finishes. He relies on his early speed and must be on the lead to be a factor. **SYSTEM GW GINNY (7)** has great speed but must overcome this tough post position. **GOODBYE METHOD (8)** likes it wide and should take advantage of her outside post position.

Bluffs Run - 550yd/1650 ft.

SET UP TO WIN (5) has the most points with 55, and needs the front to win, as it looks as though she isn't a closer. A finalist in the 2004 Spring Futurity & Bluffs Run Open. **I AM BLACK (3)** is 7 for 10. If he's in front, it'll be tough to run him down. Needs to break his finishing pattern of 1-2-1-2-1, and now's the time. **RA BLAZER (7)** has run like a champ, winning the Bluffs Run Open, and is the win leader (27 of 51). If he gets the lead, he keeps going and tends to pull away. **YO MY HEADLINER (1)** no stranger to lighting the board, finishing in the money 22 of 29 times. He can come from behind, but he better not dally. **BE MY BENNY D (8)** can come from behind to steal this late. He can finish strong, but only there's no trouble. **RJ'S ON STAR (6)** his 1 win during the semis couldn't have been better timed to seal his spot in the finals. He's consistent at lighting the board, but not always the wins. **AFTER PARTY (2)** needs to the first turn and avoid trouble to hit the board. She'll try to come from behind as long as the leaders aren't too far out. **HISTORY SPEAKS (4)** could be the sleeper of this race. She will need to fire out and never look back. She'll have to drive all the way win.

Wonderland - 682yd/2045 ft.

This race figures to feature a speed duel. Up and coming **LOLLIPER (1)** drew the beneficial box and should be given the edge. The main threat is **ROSEGREEN BOY (7)** challenging early and has the best time in the field a blistering 37.83. **CRAIGIE FRISBY (4)** drew a tough box but is the main late speed factor and benefits from early trouble. Look for a solid effort from **FRENCH FRY (6)** always close and a money factor. **GREYS LITEOFFIRE (3)** another solid performer could be a late factor if any trouble occurs early or in the far turn. **PORT HENRY (8)** needs to get a big early lead and hope there is trouble behind him. **KL BAXTER BLACK (2)** is off a huge effort where he actually came again in the stretch. Hard Luck **AERO JET (5)** drew the dreaded 5 box but shows much late speed if he can ever get a clean run.

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Naples- Ft. Myers - 550yd/1650 ft.

TEMPO PETROCELLI (2) As our youngster of the bunch, he has risen up the ladder with relative ease. Look for him to be the early favorite. **ICU ANNIE (6)** Returning to defend her spring Night of Stars crown, she has been a force as of late. **SILENT SOLDIER (7)** with good post draw and a ton of early rush look for him to be near the front. **GR'S SAHARA (1)** with 11 of 12 in the Quinielas any trouble at the 1st turn she will not hesitate to capitalize from just off the pace. **GREAT NOMAH (4)** will be looking for an opening late. If there is, watch out! He will bring it home. **MOMONI AZTEC (3)** She will be looking to battle for the lead right from the box. She could make this race interesting. **HALLO CHARLENE (5)** Very steady runner. Gives everything she has every race. **LADY DAWG DRIVE (8)** She draws nothing but tough races all the time. She has appeared in three straight Night of Stars and she has finally drawn the outside post in a stakes race. She could be the upset winner.

Dairyland - 550yd/1650 ft.

The brightest stars in the Dairyland feature include **BLAZIN ALMA (3)** and **GUARDIAN (6)**. **GUARDIAN** comes into the race with three straight wins. He's quick out of the box and to the first turn. **GUARDIAN** has been in the six box three times in his last six starts and has won two and finished second by a neck. **BLAZIN ALMA** comes off a great six length victory in last week's Dairyland Futurity out of the eight box. Even with her early speed, she prefers to break from an outside post. **BLAZIN ALMA** doesn't like to have early speed on the outside of her. **BB's GABBY HAYS (2)**, **ROLL BABY ROLL (4)** and **CIPRIANO (8)** have been very consistent in-the-money and should be considered in the Trifecta and Superfecta. **MY DIZZY GIRL (1)** is the most consistent stakes runner of the group. Winner of last year's Dairyland Sprint, she has not finished worse than fourth in the eight stakes she competed in, including NOS XIII & X.

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Tri-State - 550yd/1650 ft.

Tri State presents an outstanding field with 7 appearing on their top 10 list and an eager juvenile looking to prove himself. 3 greyhounds return from NOS XIII. Last May **PRAIRIE SUN LEE (3)**, current wins leader, gave an exciting performance in a box to wire run holding off long shot **PEEK A JIGGLE (8)** that took 2nd by a half length. Will there be a repeat? Not if the young gun **MAGIC INGENUITY (2)** has his way. This talented juvenile steps into the national spotlight with 25 out of 26 money finishes. **HALLO IS TALENT (6)** is looking for revenge. Last May his wide run in the backstretch cost him against the speedsters. **ACE HIGH HEART (4)** is ranked #2 at Tri-State. Before her 6th place finish last week, she reeled off 8 quiniela finishes including 6 wins. **BILLY VALLIE (1)** ranked #3 prefers an inside box and a big early rush could carry him to victory. **WMS SCOOT AWAY (7)** is a well-known speedster whose 30.35 time on Oct. 15, was among the fastest posted recently. If she gets a clean break she will be hard to run down. **RK'S BUDDYBOY (5)** is known for starting slow and pouring it on. A speed jam may be beneficial. Watch him build momentum in the backstretch for a driving finish.

Palm Beach - 545yd/1635 ft.

The stars are out at Palm Beach. **SCATILLAC MEADOW (1)** has a strong inside rush. However, she will have to contend with some outside speed. **ATASCOCITA LEROY (2)** was victorious in last May's Woodland's \$200,000 Great American Greyhound Futurity and won the PBKC's \$20,000 Labor Day Puppy Stakes. Another pup, **DECO FANTASTIC (3)** is starting to blossom winning three of his last four races. With two rushers to his immediate left, he could challenge early. **A STAN'S ARMY (4)** is another strong rusher who's been in the quiniela in 15 of 25 PBKC starts. **WTD COUNTRY GOLD (5)** is the youngest and became the first greyhound in PBKC history to win his first seven races. Tonight's race will be a good test for the young star. Returning champ **MATT'S GULF (6)** looks to set the pace, he has the best time of 29.59. **SHALL WE SEA (7)** is coming into her own of late. This inside rusher has reeled off four straight. She can close strong to win, but must get close early against this field. **PUD MEADOWS (8)** has the post advantage: 5 & 7 will cut to rail giving this pup the passing lane all to himself.



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Derby Lane - 660yd/1980 ft.

From the West Coast of FL tonight's Derby Lane field is presented over a new clay and sand surface with a slight outside advantage. **NON STOP FUN (3)** has been winning non-stop over the longer course. She boasts the same lines as the legendary Talentedmrrripley and will be the heavy favorite. Her kennel-mate **I'M ZEE BEST (8)** is a slow starter with a big finish running 2nd to her last week. **WHYTELL SCRABBLE (6)** a dual distance stakes winner won the 2002 Tampa NOS Sprint and the St. Pete Derby Consolation in 2003. At age 4 and climbing, he holds his own and should factor. **BD'S NOREEN (5)** placed 2nd in last month's Tampa Derby. The short rest should have her ready. **LINCKIA (2)** should continue his slow breaking style and consistent money finish. **DREAMSICLE (7)** has drawn favorably. Though not expected to upset the field, he could pose a major threat. **MY DEAL (4)** recently climbed to the top grade and may be outclassed. She will be a longshot that will return big. **COUNTRY LORE (1)** pulled away from the field the last time she wore red. She too recently climbed to the top grade and finished a respectable second to Non Stop Fun two starts ago.

Wheeling - 548yd/1643 ft.

Two undefeated greyhounds highlight the finals of the \$50,000 Couch Potato Stakes. **GREYS ROYALCROWN (3)** with the best qualifying time at 29.99, makes his 2nd straight finals appearance. Not to be outdone, **FLYING TREY BOY (6)** is on a roll performance wise winning his last 5 races and 6 out of his last 7. Tonight is also a family affair as brothers **BOONE'S LINKY (5)** and **BOONE'S FISHNKID (2)** (who been in the trifecta in his 15 Wheeling starts) looked impressive and matched qualifying records with a victory and two 2nd place finishes each. **FLYING TAG HEUER (1)** was just a length short of being undefeated coming into tonight's race. **KAY V WILLARD (8)** will be looking for the rail tonight and has been a model of consistency lately, not missing a trifecta since July 10th! **LEWIS AND WAX (7)** loves the outside and can close on the best of them. He has only missed the superfecta 5 times in 41 start. **LONESOME CRY (4)** squeaked into the finals with 2 impressive back-to-back wins, including the biggest win payoff of the qualifying rounds, going off at over 89-1 just 2 starts ago.

Orange Park - 550yd/1650 ft.

ITSA CUPPA CHEER (1) gets a good post position to use her early speed to her advantage. Winner in 3 of her last 6 starts and 6 on the meet has a record from this post of 3-1-1-0-0. **WIX NATHANIEL (2)** has made the trifecta from the inside in his last 5 races and a win by 8 lengths. He's 7 for 8 in the super from this post (8-1-3-2-1). **BLACK ICE (3)** is the win leader with 7 and has the meet's best time at 30.22. He's a monster on the lead and won 3 of 7 tries from this post (7-3-0-1-0). **DEAMONA (4)** may not win a lot, but can sure make it to the money. She has good late speed and has a record of 8-1-0-3-1 from this post. **DG'S U TOO (5)** has won 3 of his last 4, and has been in the trifecta in 6 straight. He has a good rush to the turn, with plenty left in the tank late. 5 box is ok with him (5-1-1-2-0) **KIOWA SHAG SUE (6)** a rail runner in a tough post here, but if she breaks it won't matter much. She has won 6 races on the meet with an 11 length romp 3 races back. (5-1-1-2-0) **BACK RIVER (7)** is the perpetual bridesmaid that is still looking for a win in a stakes as she has been 2nd or 3rd in the last 4. Winner of her last 2 has a record of 7-3-0-1-0 from here. **PAK SEMINOLE WIN (8)** winner of 3 of her last 6 starts, she is the only stakes winner in the field and that win was also from the 8 box. Post record (12-6-1-1-1)

Birmingham - 550yd/1650 ft.

BY'S VENUS (1) is a steady mid-rail runner with early speed and has 23 of 26 starts in the money. **ALBION CAROLINE (2)** is another early speed, mid-rail greyhound that will clear early. **JJ SMOKE SIGNAL (3)** a mid-track runner with a steady effort. **IGOBY BRADY (4)** is the youngest greyhound in race. Will give a solid effort, likes mid-track. 23 of 26 starts in money figures well with open box between 4 and 5 box. **MDM ELITE TIGER (5)** a strong, mid-track runner who will rush first to the turn. 9 of 10 starts in the money contends for win. **PARIS DOMINATOR (6)** a mid-track runner who needs the turn. Capable of good close. **TYVILLE STITCH (7)** mid-widester can contend for trifecta and superfecta. **MIZ STELLA (8)** is a mid-wide runner in a good spot to finish in the money with a strong close.



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Flagler - 550yd/1650 ft.

There's a young stud turning heads in South Beach and it's not a Ben Affleck or Jude Law; this guy has those cute puppy dog eyes. **CAN YOU HEAR ME (2)** is getting through loud and clear at Flagler winning eight of his nine career starts in dominating fashion. But, there's something about Mary! **HALLO MARY (6)** is the win leader at Flagler winning 17 of 28 starts. **FINALDESTINATION (3)** has stakes experience reaching the semifinals of the World Classic and Hollywoodian. Post may be the ultimate equalizer as **HEY TAXI (1)** took the checkered flag in four of five from the pole position. Lea's been sly as a fox: **HALLO FOX LEA (5)** has a pair of wins and seconds in four starts from mid-post. Meantime, one look at his record from outside (23 8-8-3-2) and you'll really like **LOOKED N LIKED (7)**. With the post advantage, this guy can, "DRIFTALONG" (8) with a clear lane outside. A recent vacation has the **LEMON DROP GUY (4)** freshened up and in top form.

Gulf - 550yd/1650 ft.

ML'S SWITCHBLADE (1) is the wildcard in this race. He generally runs 3/8, and is exceptional; however, his sprinting ability is really shining lately, and he should be tough from this post. **SECRET SWAGGER (2)** is the newly crowned Texas Fall Sprint Champion and can close like a monster. Drawing the 2-post should be a big advantage. **CASSIES GOT GAME (3)** will need the front early to make her mark, but if she gets it, "Katy bar the door!" **DOBKIN (4)** has the best early speed in the race, if she is willing to use it. When she goes to the front, she likes to drift to the outside. **GABLE MATRIX (5)** shows two AA wins in his last three starts. He has the ability to grab the win, but does he have the early speed? **SAN TAN TY-PHOON (6)** should be a bargain at the windows. He is one of the fastest at the track and could show his stuff tonight! **DLT TEXAS FLEET (7)** is tough on the front end of the race, recently running 2nd in the Fall Classic. She must hold a bit tougher in the stretch. **ZANKSAUN (8)** has been a solid AA competitor all year and could steal the show.

Southland - 583yd/1749 ft.

RJ'S NOWILDCARDS (1) quickly climbed the grade ladder by winning 4 straight. This inside runner should be extra strong from the 1 post. The breaker, stayer hugs the rail and may be tough to catch. **OKIE CASHIER (2)** doesn't break well, but knows where the front is, so don't count him out. His inside style should suit him well here. **SEEINIS BELIEVIN (3)** is no stranger to the money with 10 wins & 10 2nd in 2004. She likes to run mid-track and is a strong rusher. It should be a mad dash to the turn. **SAS KENNY (4)** is a late speed, rail runner, with 11 wins in 2004. He should break to the rail immediately. **TEXANNA CHRISTINE (5)** runs well from the middle. A wagering favorite in 4 of her last 5 starts, she has settled well in the top grade since coming from Birmingham. **I WANT THE FRONT (6)** breaks well and prefers the inside to middle posts. She should go to the front early, but must break to be a contender. **BRIAN'S TRIXIE (7)** may be slightly out of position here, but with a fast break, she could be a spoiler. A moderate breaker, she'll need room to contend. **WB'S SHOCK N AWE (8)** literally flies out of the box, and with 3 straight recent wins at this distance, AWESome is right.

Tucson - 550yd/1650 ft.

They'll be some tumbleweeds flyin' and dust kickin' up at Tucson. **LADY ELM (6)** may be the quickest on the draw as she shoots for four straight. So is **DESIGNING ACTOR (1)**, who leads the way with sixteen season wins. Tucson's top kennel has two chances to be the streak stopper: The Blair Kennel will send **BG ANTAGONIST (3)** to stalk the leaders; sparks may fly if **BELLA ELECTRON (2)** shakes loose as she owns the fastest time at 30.40. The crafty veteran **WIX DANA (8)** will work smart, not hard, to find a room for her desert stretch run. If **PLACEINTHESUN (7)** finds a place on the rail, then there's a place in the Night of Stars winner circle with her name on it. **SUN MEADOW S (4)** has found a new home since moving in from Phoenix, now she needs to find the lead to have a chance. **AC GALAXY FOGG (5)** should get clear sailing and will be flying late in the passing lane. It's a Double in the desert! Welcome to Arizona for a Night of Stars Daily Double!



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Phoenix - 550yd/1650 ft.

Early speed is always the hot ticket at Phoenix, and tonight's Night of Stars feature is an early speed battle of epic proportions. In a great spot to prevail in the rush to the turn is **MOON MT DIPPER (4)**. This lightning-quick pup began her career with an unprecedented 12 consecutive victories, and she has the firepower to dash by the three greyhounds to her left. **MY BLONDE HONEY (1)** is our current win leader and she runs well regardless of post position. 2nd in victories at PGP in 2004 is **COLDWATER THEDA (8)**, and this speed merchant loves to scamper to the turn from the eight box. Swift rookies **TIMELESS JOURNEY (6)** and **JR'S OMEGA (7)** also are rockets to the turn from the outside, and both have already proven that they can take down top sprinters. If you're looking for finish, 2003 Juvenile Stake runner-up **TWICE AZ PERPLEX (5)** is your guy. **CONCHO MAGPIE (3)** and **USS KINGDOM (2)** run well inside but both may be lost in the shuffle early.
