Previews

Race 1 - Raynham Park - 550 Yards

The 19th Night Of Stars will feature two returning greyhounds from the 18th Night Of Stars. **PAT C CLEMENT (5)** has won seven in a row. Although in an unfavorable post position and early speed inside, this is the greyhound to beat. **FUZZYS RUFFOLO(3)** also returning this year, will pose a formidable threat with her great early speed. **ROYAL REVERIE(4)** has been posting some of the fastest times lately, and if he gets to the front will be impossible to catch. **STARZ JIMMIE(2)** may have the best early speed of all, but better be on his game because this talented field will be in hot pursuit. **FORAY(8)** has won four in a row and has posted one of the best winning times ever a RAYNHAM PARK with a 30:04. **BAILEY'S ALONSO(6)** is late speed. This greyhound loves the outside and should be closing strong. **BRAVO KENDRA(1)** and **WILLY FIX IT(7)** are always in the money, it will be difficult for either to win but they should definitely be part of your superfecta plays.

Race 2 - Daytona Beach Kennel Club - 550 Yards

WTD SO WHAT NOW (1) Can't fine a more consistant female. Always runs hard, midtrack and will give a good account of herself. **RC'S SORCERER (2)** Repeat performer in the Night Of Stars. Must get to the rail to do his damage. **LURENZ (3)** World of early speed. Should he make front he's capable of going all the way. **STARZ JAYLIN (4)** Very nice young dog showing a lot of potential. Can be an early threat or run you down. **HEAT IT UP CREED (5)** Loads of early speed along the rail. Could easily go all the way in front. **PTL LOIS (6)** Always gives her best effort and is one tough cookie. She has the speed to lead all the way midtrack. **SOLARECLIPSEDAME (7)** Hard running female who always gives her best racing midtrack. She will need things to go here way to beat this bunch. **D'S ONSTAR (8)** Not yet two years old but still able to run with the best. He definetly wants to be along the rail.

Race 3 - Naples-Ft. Myers - 770 Yards

GREYS SWING GATE (1) will look to swing the gate shut on this field. Winner of 2007 Hurricane Clsassic.This is her race to lose. Of the 21 wins 10 are from this distance. **NEWYORK NEWYORK (2)** This pup loves to draft, will look for his opening in the stretch to challenge. **KELSOS HIFALUTIN (3)** Is the biggest threat to favorite. If he can avoid traffic early, he will be coming in the stretch. **KIOWA DAME (4)** 68%in the money. His style is a steady knocker. **MR.TOKEN (5)** is a young pup, although he doesn't show a lot on paper 3 of his 4 wins have come over this distance. **BARTS SUNKIST (6)** with his early speed will look to show these monsters the way to the wire. **KAIAS CAPRI (7)** Needs a clean trip to be a contender in this field. **BARTS HAMMERLOCK (8)** Don't that this last race fool you. He is back from a 1 month vacation and looking to drop the hammer again.

Race 4 - Wonderland Greyhound Park - 550 Yards

Early in the 2007 meet at Wonderland the question being asked is can anyone stop **SNOWBLOWER (2)**? His impressive record at Sarasota and his ability to do just enough to win should make him the prohibitive favorite. **NEFTAL (7)** challenged the streak to deep stretch in his last and is the primary challenger. **O BOY PHIL (4)** is a classy contender who needs running room. She needs help here, but watch for a late charge. Big early speed on the rail is the trademark for **FLO FELT (1)**. She will be looking for early trouble and to hang on. **SCOOBIE BLUE (5)** is another one with a great late kick. The dreaded 5 box doesn't help but he could benefit from an early jam. **BB'S HE GRABS (3)** drew a tough box. He will be hard pressed to keep up early. **CONTRABAND (8)** not positioned well but has closing speed. Watch for a late sneak charge up the rail. Invader **JIT ROADRUNNER (6)** ran fine in her debut but needs help to factor here.

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Race 5 - Bluffs Run Park- 550 Yards

This is the finals for the \$60,000 Horseshoe Challenge. **BARTS NAVIGATOR (1)** must use his early speed to avoid trouble at the break. **DRIVEN TOPERFORM (2)** outclassed here won his last race thanks to a huge benefit. **BARTS KODA (3)** will break to the rail & cause tonight, his recklessness is his demise. **BARTS ACE HIGH (4)** Spring Futurity Champion in another final. He could get a big opening thanks to the 3 clearing the way. **JR B'S BARKNBUD (5)** needs the front. If he gets it he's gone, if not still look for him to hit the board. **MALIBU WANDA (6)** the only female in the finals coming around, this race will be a huge measuring stick for her. **YO MY MEDIATOR (7)** current track champion, in his first stakes race at Bluffs Run. He's the fastest greyhound here & will be the favorite. **TC'S HOMER (8)** he made the finals, a clean race and he should hit the board.

Race 6 - Tri-State Racetrack - 550 Yards

A good break may be all it takes, as anyone can win. **LR'S SPUNK (1)** is a closer who drives from mid-field to give the leaders a run for their money. **BD'S HAJI (2)** is a driving mid-track racer who may assess the field early before looking for the mid to outside lanes. **CAJUN CAIN (3)**, the retuning N.O.S. champ could easily defend his title by claiming the mid to outside pass early. **CITY PLACE (4)** needs to avoid trouble going into the turn, so that he can light the afterburners late. **FRED WEASLEY (5)** is a closer who may be a favorite. All he needs is an inside lane to drive in. **HALLO BOSTON TED (6)** breaks early from this position and just might be able to wire the field. **CRAIGIE PLUSH (7)** is hot as of late and loves the outside. **K ANGEL RASCAL (8)** has definitely had some help from above with the consistency she has shown recently. Will divine intervention prove itself again and place her in the money?

Race 7 - Dairyland Park - 550 Yards

MY JOHNNYS WISH (7) enters the race having won four races in a row by a combined 32 lengths. He has proven he can win from anywhere. **SECRETOAK (2)** is hot after taking some time off. He has won 3 of 4 since returning to live racing action. **TYVILLE ESCALADE (4)** has turned into a winner stacking up 12 wins in 22 starts this meet. **EMERALD QUAKER (5)** always steps up her game when the spotlight is on. She has won 5 stakes titles including 2 this year. Early speed threats **CALS EAT MY DUST (3)** and **TORINO TALENT (8)** will try to find the front end early and make the other greyhounds work for the win. **MOTO QUICK SET (1)** is looking for her second straight NOS victory. Quick Set surprise many at 12-1 in Night of Stars XVIII. Don't forget about the veteran **BLAZIN KANG (6)** as he makes up ground late in the stretch.

Race 8 - Mardi Gras - 550 Yards

BBR BE AFRAID (1) needs to rush up early and clear to be a factor Here. **RBI RAMIREZ (2)** the youngster, maybe in over his head but has Hit the board 9 of 14 races. **JC'S DAWSON (3)** has been noting but solid At Mardi Gras, should be a factor in this race. **SPRINGWATER JAB (4)** is a stakes winner he needs to break early to win. **SPEED ROUSER (5)** is good Early speed and likely to be in the trifecta in this race. **STARZ ARNOLD (6)** is a promising pup he has an outside shot to win. **BOHEMIAN BRASH (7)** tons of early speed if Brash clears he will be tough to stop. **ROOFTOP JABBER (8)** also must pop the lid to win, she sit's good in the 8 hole.

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Race 9 - Palm Beach Kennel Club- 545 Yards

This round one \$120,000 Palm Beach Grand Classic qualifier looks to be a real knock-down slobberknocker! Set up to get out early and arrive at the first turn in the first wave are future All-American, and the largest money earner in Greyhound racing history, **FLYING STANLEY (5)** along with Gulf Greyhound Park's March Mania champ **TOMMY COMMANDER (6)**. And don't count out local hometown heroes **LEVELED OUT (2)** and **JACK WHISTLER (7)**, both of whom have pretty much been having their own way on the Palm Beach oval. Any trouble at the 1st turn would give power-house closer **WTD RIGHT RIGHT (1)** a clear venue to duck underneath any early trouble. And don't count out the Irish import **ENERGY FORCE* (3)** who overcame adversity that should have taken him out of the money in his last effort. **VAN DO (4)** needs help to get him in position at the first turn. But with a Volusia County record, 16 of 17 quiniela finishes, it is very possible! Rounding out the race is Wheeling's **LONESOME BREAKER (8)** who needs an big break & has to avoid any contact with the other entries as he demands the inside on his trek to the first turn.

Race 10 - Derby Lane- 550 Yards

EXTRUDING DREAM'S (7) dual distance talents landed him the 2006 Flashy Sir award and a spot on the All America Team. DREAM seeks a 2nd stakes at 550 this year & will come out flying, but could fall prey to **KIOWA ZAPPER JAY (5)** a speed merchant that won 4 of his last 8 starts from the middle of the pack. **TOP CAT ORSON (4)** won NOS XVI from post 5 in a stretch rally. He was underestimated before and should not be discounted. **FLYING WYNNEWOOD (2)** prefers an outside post but is the freshest in the field coming off a 4 week layoff. **CTW NEWSREEL (1)** drew the rail pole. He is one of the fastest and should benefit early by outrushing his inside rivals. **GREYS SHERLUCK (3)** is a slumping front runner. She will need a big break to contend. **SOL DELI (6)** a formidable female was a 4th place finisher in this year's Derby Lane Million Consolation. **LORAC (8)** a longshot drew an unfavorable 8 box that should see her break quickly to the rail.

Race 11 - Orange Park Kennel Club - 550 Yards

The 2006 All-American **KAY V TATOO TONY (7)** (11-9-0-0-1) heads into his 3rd straight Night of Stars Feature. He's been short in the past, but with 6 straight wins from this post, tonight might be the night. **FTH JIVE TALKER (1)** (3-1-0-1-0) is the fastest greyhound at the racetrack and he's hot winning 4 of 6. He was 2nd in NOS XVIII. **STAKE YOUR CLAIM (2)** (15-7-1-4-1) loves the rail and he has won 2 straight and 3 of his last 4 efforts. **PTL JUNEBUG (3)** (5-1-1-2-1) has loads of early speed and it's no surprise if she is on the early lead, but holding it will be a task tonight. **PENROSE BRIANNA (6)** (11-6-0-0-1) is getting back into form winning her last 2 straight. If she breaks well tonight, she will factor in this effort. **MAGIC REMI (5)** (12-5-1-1-3) is a strong closer that will make up ground throughout tonight. Breaking from a tough post, he will need some help up front if he wants to win this race. **BARTS LAP DOG (4)** (11-2-0-2-3) is a gamer that leaves it all on the racetrack. Others might have bigger names, but he has a bigger heart. **PAT C RED NOTE (8)** (4-1-2-0-0) is an early speed greyhound that needs to get out to be effective. With 21 wins on the meet, you can't forget about him if he shakes loose.

Race 12 - Wheeling Island - 678 Yards

Tonight's field of eight can boast over 50 wins so far this season. **CAFE QUEEN (1)** drew a very favorable box and has four straight quiniela finishes. **GABLE CUIDADO (2)** had six straight wins on this course earlier this year but has cooled off lately. **ARMYS MISTRESS (3)** is currently on a streak of 13 straight trifecta finishes. She has also racked together 5 straight wins in that streak. TNJ **RODEO JOE (4)** can boast 11 straight finishes in the trifecta, but will need the lead if he has any hopes of winning tonight. **CS BOSCO (5)** is currently riding 19 straight starts in "AA" and 13 of 16 starts have been in the trifecta. **GENISIS PLACE (6)** has won 4 of her last six starts by an average winning margin of six lengths! **OPALESCENT (7)** has never won from the seven or eight box since coming to Wheeling but has the talent to hang with this field. **WHALING WILDFIRE (8)** has 18 straight starts in "AA" coming into tonight, with nine wins during this streak averaging nearly 5 lengths each!



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Race 13 - Gulf Greyhound Park - 660 Yards

CL TEXAS STAR (1) just one week ago, won the Round Up, but it was a 550 contest, can he hang in the 660? He should be the favorite here. **U TOO GRACELAND (2)** likes either distance, but he's been very hot over the 550. Coming off a 5 race winning streak, he should go to the front. **SAN TAN VIEW (3)** earlier won 7 straight. She is capable of busting the box and leaving the field behind. **BUTTON HOLE (4)** comes into this race as a hard charging sprinter. A mid-track racer, she'll fly up near the end of the race. **SAN TAN DOG GONE (5)** won three straight races in mid-April. She can come out of the box strong, or close off the pace. **A'S ARISTOTLE (6)** needs a good break to have a chance down the stretch. Coming into this contest with 2 straight wins is a real plus. **P'S RACY KATY (7)** has never gone this far before but looks like she can run all day. The outside box will help her chances. **BOB'S WAL (8)** is a littermate to Rural Rube Award winner Bob's Skeet and can be equally as impressive. A former \$15,000 Texas Fall Classic Champion in 2005, he knows how to win the big one.

Race 14 - Southland Gaming & Racing - 703 Yards

LAZYK TREYK CABO (1) likes to jump out early and hug the rail. This is a favorable post for this rail bird. **DIVULGE (2)** was Southland's 2006 Greyhound of the Year and she's working hard on repeating that in '07. Divulge is in search of her 5 straight win and will no doubt be the race time favorite. **BF SLAMMER (3)** is a slow breaker who finds his groove late in the race. Slammer could be a contender tonight if the pace doesn't leave him behind. **KIOWA APPLE LYDE (4)** is the biggest threat for Divulge tonight. This talented 2 year old has only missed the pay sheet 3 times this year. **METICULOUS DREAM (5)** is considered the upset pick. She is capable of coming out strong or closing fast. **TF WALKIN TALL (6)** has a win showing at this distance and can come from behind to catch the leaders. **WINCHESTER DRIVE (7)** is another tough competitor who stands in the way of Divulge and is another racer tonight who has only missed pay day 3 times this year. **KAREEM (8)** likes this wide draw and stalks the leaders looking for room to make his move.

Race 15 - Tucson Greyhound Park - 550 Yards

SOL LIKE MIKE (8) has got the post position and the late chops to run down all the early speed in this race. With 4 wins in 6 starts, he is the one to beat tonight. **KIOWA RIVERROYAL (6)** won't make it easy for MIKE. He too has 4 wins in 6 races and has some closing ability of his own. **TOOTSY GOODBYE (3)** is the speed merchant of this field and will most likely be the one to catch off of the late lead. If she steals enough, she has a shot to win tonight. **SOL MOTTO (4)** is close enough to the rail to be dangerous here. With a late rush, you can't count him out. **COLDWATER KICK (5)** lives up to his name once again in this effort. He might not win a lot, but he mikes into the money. **RC SHAME ON YOU (1)** can break on occasion and keeps coming even without the lead. Watch for a big finish and a possible money effort. **LPH PLAYER (7)** has some good early speed and might even challenge for the early lead. Trouble is he is way to short in the stretch. **FLEA'S MERCEDES (2)** the only greyhound in the field not in grade A. Just plain overmatched tonight.

Race 16 - Phoenix - 550 Yards

Since Phoenix Greyhound Park greyhounds rarely venture outside of Arizona, the Night of Stars is the one chance our fastest hounds have to take center stage nationally. Looking to assume the starring role in tonight's production is **COLDWATER TORRES (2)**, who has won 18 of his last 19 races and 12 in succession. Our 2006 track champ flopped as the choice in our Night of Stars XVIII feature so he'll try to make amends tonight. Torres' lone 2007 defeat came at the paws of **DRIFTING DARBY (5)**, but Darby has not been at his best lately. With a real chance to upset Coldwater Torres are **BC DEUCES WILD (4)** and **SAVVY NONI (6)**, both of whom are in prime time form. **BLACK MAY (8)** loves to go from the eight box and is always dangerous. If fast finish is your game, hope for a late run from **RD'S QWEST (1)**, who can come from far off the pace. Likely to be caught in traffic early are **BELLA IAMBIC (3)** and **ACTIVIST (7)**.
