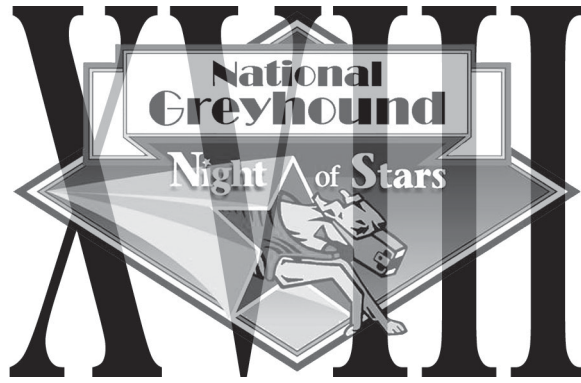

Greyhounds are affectionate, friendly, and thrive on attention and human companionship. They make excellent pets for families with children and senior citizens. Surprisingly, greyhounds don't need excessive amounts of exercise and spend quite a lot of time sleeping.

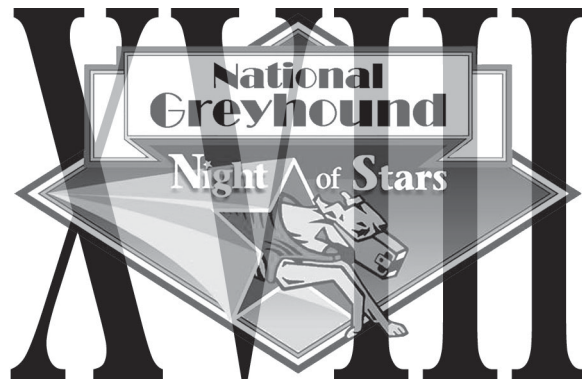
