Previews

Race 1 - RAYNHAM TAUNTON - 550 Yards

PAT C CLEMENT (7) will try to defend his title as Night of Stars Champion. He's the current win leader and definitely the greyhound to beat. **KENTON KRIME(1)** is sitting in a favorable post & could be a definite threat to the defending champ. **DJAYS INEEDSPEED (4)** recently arrived from Wheeling and his great closing speed makes him a threat if there is any early trouble. **INGA'S CLIFF (2)** is one of the most underrated greyhounds here. He has made a paycheck in 42 starts and is always a good play on the ticket. **HELLO N BYE BYE (3)** at first glance looks like he doesn't belong, but he has only run worse than 4th in one start since August 22. **LAZY K JARVIS (5)** is a threat to win anytime. Should this greyhound get to the front he is difficult to catch and has won over half of this starts this year. **STARZ CLASSIC (6)** is about as dependable as they come. This greyhound has been in the Quiniela 14 of 15 starts and is a definite threat to keep the streak going. **SOL LOGAN (8)** just seven days ago won the Raynham Sprint Championship. He has blazing speed and is difficult to chase down.

Race 2 - DAYTONA BEACH KENNEL CLUB - 550 Yards

GIVE IT A CHANCE (1) Is a hard running competitor who does the best possible everytime. He makes the paysheet often. Racing on the wide side. **N MATLOCK (2)** Needs to get up near the front and with a burst of wide speed he can give a good account of himself. **ETHEREAL ESTEEM (3)** Not yet two years old, but already taking care of business. A steady performer racing midtrack. **GRACIOUS ANGELA (4)** With plenty of starts at Daytona she knows her way around the track. Her lines tell all. **CORDA WOULD (5)** From maiden to grade A in a flash. She's a big female who won't settle for second. Racing midtrack. **FUZZYS OLETA (6)** Up and coming young pup. Has early speed but needs to be outside. **PRU WHISTLER (7)** Can beat you around the turn or come and get you. She doesn't make any mistakes and prefers to run some wide. **BLAZE N RAY (8)** What a dog - He has blistered the competition with his blinding speed. Barely missing the track record several times.

Race 3 - TWIN RIVER - 550 Yards

This is going to be a tough race to the turn. It's anyone's night. **SOLITARY GALOXY (1)** is where he wants to be. Once in the lead, he's hard to catch. **TAPCO GROOVE (2)** had a tough trip last time out but should not be overlooked as a competitor. **Day Trader Cat (3)** has been running consistently at this level lately and **IMPERIOLI'S WAY (4)** has the speed to make the board. It's been a month since **Get Ready Melody (5)** claimed the 2007 Twin River Sprint title and she'll be vying for a chance to show that it wasn't just a one time deal. **TK Rocket Man (6)** was a finalist in the American Greyhound Derby- even going into it the favorite and **CHEVITA (7)**, was also a finalist and a favorite but in the Twin River Sprint back in late September. Finally, **NITA'S KINSEY (8)** recently came back from a month long layoff and celebrated her return with a first place finish. She'd probably prefer the inside but will try to make up some ground for the win.

Race 4 - TRI-STATE RACETRACK & GAMING 550 Yards

Break or go home. That's the determining factor in this race. **JIMI HENDRIX (1)** track record holder at 29.68 for 550 & has posted 7 wins in 10 races. Tri-State's top athlete is a fast and furious threat to any field. **WV'S NELLIS (2)** is a West Virginia bred greyhound & can run with the best of them. If she can claim the rail she could have a shot at the win. **USS DICAPRIO (3)** is a mid-track racer who has shown both early speed and strong driving finishes. **MYOKIE FLOYD (4)** is 3rd in the win standings and is no stranger to a mid-track box to wire finish. **HALLO LIL LASS (5)** with 29 of 37 in the money this quick consistent racer has a little extra drive late in the race. **JIMBO TUESDAY (6)** has earned the most purse money this season when compared to the other nine greyhounds. **LUCKY WOOKIE (7)** is a contender to keep an eye on for tonight's race. **CB'S MEMORY (8)** shows some impressive stats. Memory has won 5 of 10 races and should drive late for a impressive finish.

Race 5 - BLUFFS RUN GREYHOUND PARK - 550 Yards
The \$450,000 Iowa Breeders Classic. **KJ'S YUKON GOLD (1)** is the top Iowa bred greyhound at Bluffs Run. He should break quick and will be tough to catch. **COLORADO CHRIS (2)** may not like his inside post. He gets a little claustrophobic with someone on his right shoulder. **JOIN THE FUN (3)** ran well in the 2nd round and Quarters but could come up short in the finals. **B'S MANFRED (4)** won early in qualifying, but caught late in the later rounds. He'll need some luck tonight. **SUPERIOR MOVER (5)** won from here in the 1st round. Unless she breaks close, it may be a tough night. **DOUBT FREE (6)** point leader in qualifying & was almost undefeated to the finals. Should come charging in the home stretch. **KJ'S KAYLA GIRL (7)** came on strong in the Quarters and Semis. She'll need to break quickly to light the board. **GOOD ENOUGH (8)** squeaked in and drew a tough post. Might be a long night.

Race 6 - DAIRYLAND GREYHOUND PARK - 550 Yards
SWEET ASHLEY(1) Loves the inside part of the racetrack and should benefit from this post position. **KAY V SOUTH WEST(2)** A hard knocking competitor who is rarely out of the picture. Has the speed and staying power to be a major factor in this race. **KAY V KEEP WET(3)** Used closing kick to reel in a victory last Sat eve in the Dairyland Futurity. **BB'S ASIXTYSGIRL(4)** Sired by the great Gable Dodge this fawn female does not back down from a challenge. Prefers midtrack running and can upset if she avoids trouble. **OHBOOMPOWSUPRISE(5)** A great treat to watch her race. Current track win leader w/ 30 wins in 50 starts. Winner of the Dairyland Sprint Stakes and All Star Challenge earlier this meet. She set the track record for consecutive victories with 12 in a row earlier this summer. **TYVILLE BOONE(6)** Junior J's speedster is hot racer of late with three wins in a row going into this one. **SE'S CUFF A SPOT(7)** Silverhawk racer can spot a hole and dash thru making her a dangerous competitor. **BL KISS THIS(8)** Since coming from Bluff's this greyhound has been on a tear, winning 10 of 16 in impressive fashion.

Race 7 - NAPLES - FT. MYERS - 660 Yards
KIOWA LOGAN (1) has some good early speed & should make the most of the post. The break will be critical for her tonight. **GREYS SWING GATE (2)** is clearly the favorite to win this race. He can run all 3 distances and when he's in front it's all over. **KIOWA KAY KELLY (3)** is a good closer that is moving up in class here. Next best last time to Swing Gate, maybe 2 in a row. **SWEET TOM (4)** with 4 wins in 5 races this greyhound must be considered a threat, especially since he likes to race midtrack. **KELSOS HIFALUTIN (5)** will be back & wide early on in this race, but don't count her out too soon. She has great closing ability & will be flying late. **BARTS SUNKIST (6)** posted well in this effort this stalking greyhound will keep up the good work of 6 trifecta races in a row. **BARTS FOCALPOINT (7)** runs her best from the outside and could not have asked for a better post. **Gil's Cisco (8)** might be short late, but should challenge the leaders early, especially from his best box.

Race 8 - MARDI GRAS - 550 Yards
STARZ JENKO(1) is the greyhound to catch. He's coming off 3 straight wins & has the rail which makes him even more dangerous. **STARZ JOHNNY BOY(2)** has been runner up to Starz Jenko in his last 2 starts. He needs a strong effort to complete here. **HALLO GOLD ACRE(3)** is one of 3 O'Donnell entries tonight & is sired by former World classic Champ Hallo West Acre. **HG AUTOBAHN(4)** is coming off a win in his last start, but draws a tough spot here. **HALLO MR DALTON(5)** climbed the ladder from maiden to A in very swift fashion & has a strong late kick. **TMC'S FASTRACK(6)** has a strong in the money record & needs to be up early to be a factor. **RBI RAMIREZ(7)** has won 25 races & gets a good outside post here. **WIN IT FOR ME(8)** is the leading purse winner in this field and can take it all here from a good outside post.

Race 9 - PALM BEACH KENNEL CLUB - 545 Yards

Palm Beach Kennel Club's Night of Stars event features the best of the tracks early speedsters, strong first-turn rushers and hardcore come-from-behind powerhouses. The likely wagering favorites look to be **JD TOMMYBOY (1)** (5-3-0-1-1), who will be going for his fourth consecutive victory, and multi-stakes finalist **NOBOOTH FOR GARY (7)** (20-8-5-0-1). Back-to-back race victor **DECO CARLO (2)** (29-9-7-4-2), who prefers to race on the outside, may encounter some early problems from the duo of early inside-racing speedsters **WTD DAILY NEWS (3)** (22-5-1-2-3) and **PAT C LAKE ERIE (4)** (31-7-4-5-2). Strong first-turn rusher **GREYS SKYCAPTAIN (6)** (22-6-2-3-3) is racing near the top of his game, but post position seems not to be in his favor. **JW BREWER BOY (8)** (29-8-4-6-1) looks to be in a favorable spot in that most of the Night of Stars competitors like to rush the first turn with an inside bias. This would give him ample early racing room. And laying back in the wings will be the never-say-quit kid **TATIANNA EPISODE (5)** (23-5-4-7-1), who will be coming on like gang busters down the homestretch.

Race 10 - DERBY LANE - 550 Yards

Sunglasses are needed to view Derby Lane's star-studded field boasting the Million Dollar champion and six time stakes winner **FLYING STANLEY (3)**. The highest earning greyhound in the world \$630,000. This race previews the '08 Million where STANLEY is the favorite. **BRADY THOMAS (7)** last year's All-American Team II recipient is the win leader that has had bad luck in this year. His luck could change tonight. **DERMATOPHYTE (6)** or, the streak buster, was the only greyhound to upset Stanley in the Fall Sprint. He is positioned to threaten again. **RED DIRT ROAD (2)** has a perfect quiniela record from here. He recovers well from trouble & can rush early or charge late. **EBOR HERO (1)** is posted perfect and is rested from a 6 month layoff. Distance Classic winner **FLYIN BRIDGEPORT (8)** will have his hands full with the top notch sprinters but don't discount his closing ability. **SOL DELI (4)** was in last May's NOS race where she ran into trouble. The only female, will need some racing luck tonight. **USS TALLADEGA (5)** has competed at 3 tracks this year & has found a home in FL. Tough post but if he finds an opening he could upset.

Race 11 - ORANGE PARK KENNEL CLUB - 550 Yards

Another donnybrook tonight! **GREYS BIG SHOW (1)** (17-6-3-4-0) is an early speed greyhound that always runs tough wearing red. **KIOWA WISH FRANK (2)** (6-4-2-0-0) is the 2007 puppy champ who has matured into a top notch greyhound winning 4 of 6 starts. **KAY V TATTO TONY (3)** (20-11-3-2-1) is an 80 race winner & 2006 All-American. In 4 Night of Stars races he has not missed the ticket. **AFLEET ALEX (4)** (1-1-0-0-0) is an All-American candidate that had won 7 races in a row. The man now at the Orange Park Kennel Club, he is the favorite. **FTH JIVE TALKER (5)** (8-2-3-1-0) can never be considered out of a race. If he wants to run he could leave this field in his dust. **STAKE YOUR CLAIM (6)** (21-6-5-4-3) wasn't supposed to win in NOS XIX either, but proved best at the wire. This cagey veteran is way overdue. **PENROSE BRIANNA (7)** (14-7-3-1-2) is back into the form that made her a dominate force at the Orange Park Kennel Club. She's the hottest of the bunch with 5 wins in a row. **GIL'S LAMPASAS (8)** (9-0-1-4-1) runs way tougher than his odds ever show. Tough post for him, but with his closing ability he still has a shot in this tough race.

Race 12 - WHEELING ISLAND & GAMING-548 Yards

Although tonight's Wheeling race features the track's co-win leaders in Gable Pimiento and Makin Bakin, neither is a lock against this talented field of speedsters. **VAN DO (1)** has hit the trifecta ticket in 14 out of 15 races but prefers an outside post position. **GABLE PIMIENTO (2)** and **MAKIN BAKIN (4)** both pack tremendous early speed and should battle for the front going to the first turn. Each races better on the lead. **SOL REIGN (3)** should save ground on the inside but may need luck to shock this field. **FREYA (5)** can scoot and has a high percentage on the ticket, but must overcome a tough post position. Youngster **LEGEND OF ZORRO (6)** has plenty of bottom and has a shot if she can stay close to the leaders. **KAY SHIVON SISSY (7)** relies on her early speed and will need all she has to stay with the leaders. **SAN TAN NOMEMORY (8)** is a rising star who should get good early position. He also possesses great closing speed.

Race 13 - THE WOODLANDS - 550 Yards

KARAOKE CAT (1) Needs to be on the front. Has a non breaker to her outside so she could be in a good spot. **RED RANGER (2)** Has won his last 3 in a row. Just when you think he's a closer. He goes box to wire. A must use on the exotic tickets. **BH's RACKEM UP (3)** Finished 3rd in both the 2007 Great America Greyhound Futurity and Kansas Cup at 550 and 660 distances. Oh and also he's the track win leader with 25 and has won over \$31,000 on a non casino track! **VALS FLYER (4)** The best breaker in this quick field. Very capable if she can somehow clear. **USS RICOCHET (5)** This years favorite to win our Fall Futurity reeled off 6 in a row before Rackem got the best of him last out. **DUTCH VIKING (6)** He'll need a dream trip around the escape turn to have a shot. If trouble occurs and he gets around he could be the one. **NIMBY LEONARD (7)** The outside part of this track has been the place to be for the last month. He hasn't faced the likes of these yet. **SPECIAL TRENT (8)** 19 out of 22 starts have resulted in superfecta finishes. Not the quickest but could be the brightest. He's another Fall Futurity favorite.

Race 14 - GULF GREYHOUND PARK - 550 Yards

A hot puppy and some tough veterans battle it out in the Semi-finals of the Texas Fall Sprint Classic. **BOB'S WAL (1)** is a littermate to 2006 Rural Rube winner Bob's Skeet and shows the same flashes of greatness at times. **CL SKIP A BID (2)** has quickly become the favorite to take the trophy home. He's won 6 straight races, and has a great post to make it 7. **IZA SWEETNESS (3)** should be one of the longest shots on the board but has good early speed and could compete if on top early. **ELI SKINNER (4)** remains one of the top sprinters at Gulf. He's won his share of stakes races and is always a threat to win. **CRY CALI (5)** must get to the front out of the box and hold off a charging field. **GABLE CUIDADO (6)** checks in as the wildcard in this race. He usually runs the longer 660-yard distance, but has looked extraordinary in sprints lately. **BOB'S DESIGN (7)** is a longshot with a chance! With a big break, he can clock a very quick trip and surprise the field. **SHADOWS BYTHEBAY (8)** has drawn a bad post and will need the break of her life to take the lead on this field. She is a capable competitor, so don't count her out.

Race 15 - SOUTHLAND PARK - 660 Yards

Over 60 combined wins this season between these 8 greyhounds. **BF FRAN (1)** drew the red blanket, but prefers it wider & could cause problems. Her last win was in September, but she's been close in her last six lines. **BF GET OVER (2)** had his 7 race win streak snapped last time out. His 15 wins leads the bunch tonight. He looks to get back on track. **BF SLAMMER (3)** is a late finisher, but don't let those lines fool you. He is a veteran winner of the 660 & 703 yard courses here at Southland. **KIOWA WILL (4)** has missed the superfecta only 3 times in 23 starts. His last victory was seven starts ago in grade "A". **BARTS JERSEYGIRL (5)** is the only greyhound coming into tonight on a win streak. Of her 9 wins, 4 have come in 5 starts, 3 of which were in a row. **BRASKA INDIO (6)** is the unknown factor in tonight's race. She's never been in "AA", but 3 of her 5 wins have come at 660. **SILVER WILLOW (7)** should like the post position. She won from here 5 starts ago & eyes her 10th win of the season tonight. **KIOWA CAPRICORN (8)** dropping back to 660 & in a tough post may make her the longshot this evening.

Race 16 - TUCSON GREYHOUND PARK - 660 Yards

DUTCH ANGELIC (1) is thriving over this distance. Closing is her strong suit, watch out everyone at the finish line. **BELLA BW ROSE (2)** looks to have gotten a good post to start this race from. With 3 trifectas in a row, she is going to be tough to keep off the ticket. **TNJ KAYKAY (3)** is posted well tonight and has enough early speed to be a threat to the leaders for the duration of this race. **LPH COME TO PLAY (4)** appears to be the one to catch in this effort. Can she steal enough to hold on is the real question? **BOW FASTCASH (5)** is settling in back over the distance and has showcased late speed in his last couple of efforts. Watch out for a FAST finish tonight. **DEARDORTHYHATEOZ (6)** it's hard to ignore a box to wire win by 10 lengths and as the only true distance greyhound in the field, you might just get a price if she wants to run. **RC FLY BY (7)** forget about the trouble, this closer likes it outside. If he can get close early on then this whole field might be the ones in trouble. **PHX LIGHTSOUT (8)** is the wildcard in this race. No 660 races to compare but he seems well suited for the distance. Smelling upset? Maybe.



Race 17 - PHOENIX - 550 Yards

Once again it's fast times at Phoenix Greyhound Park, and just as it was in Night of Stars XIX, **COLDWATER TORRES (8)** is the star of the show. Torres blitzed his foes in our PGP Night of Stars Feature in May, and our 2006 Juvenile Champ and 2007 Sprint Stake winner is the hound to beat in tonight's Night of Stars finale. In a great spot to challenge Torres early is **SAVVY ANNA (1)**. This half-sister to Coldwater Torres is lightning-quick and should have running room along the rail. Worthy of attention inside as well are **SOL JOHANN (3)**, who has never been better, and **PASTIAKDOESIT (2)**, who recently dashed to six consecutive Grade AA victories. At his best from the outside is BC **MAXIMUM HEAT (6)**, and although likely to be outrun early, **TWILITE TANSY (7)** is very fast when she manages to shake loose near the front end. **BELLA CORONA (4)** and **RD'S CANTON (5)** have the best kick, but both will need to cash in on early trouble to get a big piece of this one.
