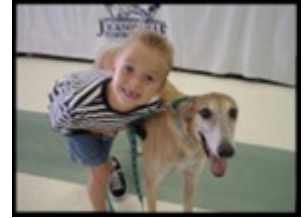

**Race 17 - PHOENIX - 550 Yards**

Once again it's fast times at Phoenix Greyhound Park, and just as it was in Night of Stars XIX, **COLDWATER TORRES (8)** is the star of the show. Torres blitzed his foes in our PGP Night of Stars Feature in May, and our 2006 Juvenile Champ and 2007 Sprint Stake winner is the hound to beat in tonight's Night of Stars finale. In a great spot to challenge Torres early is **SAVVY ANNA (1)**. This half-sister to Coldwater Torres is lightning-quick and should have running room along the rail. Worthy of attention inside as well are **SOL JOHANN (3)**, who has never been better, and **PASTIAKDOESIT (2)**, who recently dashed to six consecutive Grade AA victories. At his best from the outside is BC **MAXIMUM HEAT (6)**, and although likely to be outrun early, **TWILITE TANSY (7)** is very fast when she manages to shake loose near the front end. **BELLA CORONA (4)** and **RD'S CANTON (5)** have the best kick, but both will need to cash in on early trouble to get a big piece of this one.
