National Pick - 6 Wager



INTRODUCING EARLY AND LATE TWIN-TRIFECTAS

The minimum bet for the Twin-Trifectas will be \$2.00. For both Twin-Trifectas the pool split in the first half will be 50%. If no one correctly picks the early Twin-Trifecta, the remaining pool will be carried over to the late Twin-Trifecta and become the carryover pool. All Twin-Trifecta pools will be forced out in the late Twin-Trifecta.





Race 17 - PHOENIX PARK - 550 Yards

This race is a speed battle that will probably be decided early. Although **SAVVY SESSION (7)** recently won our Arizona Breeder's Cup stake the one to beat may be win leader **CARRIE WALSH (1)** and the perfectly boxed **KIOWA MON MELVIN (8)**. Carrie draws inside two high speed midtrack greyhounds, and because she's all rail and tough on the front end, she merits lots of respect tonight. **SAVVY SESSION (7)** is a rail slasher that bolts from the box, and this inside-seeking move should give Mon Melvin tons of room to get in gear early. **BELLA WILDWONDER (5)** is an uncatchable greyhound with explosive speed but may be caught in traffic early. **GALLORETTE (6)** just missed in the AZ Breeder's Cup, and is dangerous from off the pace. **CONCHO XANADU (2)** is a very consistent sprinter who may shake things up early. **BW'S BROADWAY (3)** is a former Night Of Stars feature winner, but she's in a terrible spot tonight. **KOYOTE NOAH (4)** was red hot earlier in the season but is trying to regain top form returning from a layoff.

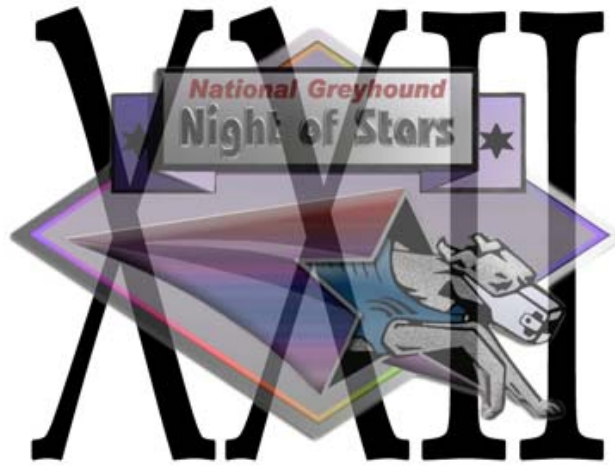
