



Race 1 - SANFORD-ORLANDO - 660 Yards

SKIDDY ADOBE (1) 11-time winner has coveted garden spot with wide runners in posts 2, 3 & 4. Set up for a perfect trip. RC **TOOTSIE ROLL (2)** Earned a check in each distance try, including nice win in most recent & may have the room to ensure a clean trip. **SKIDDY CARTEL (3)** Newcomer to the distance was beaten in most recent by two greyhounds who are also in this race. Needs clean trip. **KING AHSNOR (4)** Third in only local distance try, but was in win photo against decent field. The wild card in the race, he will be dangerous. **RC AMY MILEY (5)** Hampered by wide post last out, but has taken to route races, winning impressively & often. She needs to get in the race early, so a good break will be crucial. **KIOWA CLASS PEN (6)** Must survive the start & get to an open rail. Cannot be discounted, as the kennel has been on fire of late. **ROGUE LIL APPLE (7)** Quick starter has won 4 of last 6 & will be tough to bring down if she makes the lead. **BONNIE RUMBLE(8)** Coming off big win, but must navigate tough outside post. Must to make her presence felt early to be effective here.

Race 2 - DAYTONA BEACH - 550 Yards

KIOWA JUNE TILCO (1) Runs from the inside. She can win a race by breaking on top or closing in the end. **USS DIABLO (2)** This dog always seems to try his best. He's real consistent being on the board. **MULBERRY JOCKO (3)** Came from Sarasota seems to love Daytona. Started in grade D went straight to grade A. He'll probably be at the 1st turn on top. **GABE CHARGER (4)** She's always consistent out of 26 starts she was in the money 20 times. She'll give a good run on the rail. **BUILT TO LAST (5)** She sometimes comes up short in the end but she's a great dog to throw in your bet. **DAZZLING JEWEL (6)** She might be 4 years old but she can keep up with the pups. She likes to close up in stretch. **AUTOMATIC COLT (7)** His record says it all. Colt loves the rail but has proven he can run out of any box. He will bring it at the end. **GILDED SHERRY (8)** Won 6 in a row before falling at break. She just shook that off and came back with 3 on the board. She drew a good post.

Race 3 - FLAGLER - 647 Yards

This is setting up as a race within a race. In addition to the normal early pace versus late kick, we also have a fight for bragging rights. Three sisters square off tonight with **SERENA WILLIAMS (4)**, **MEGAN FOX (5)**, and **VENUS WILLIAMS (7)** going head to head for the first time. All three are quick at the break and all have shown the determination necessary to be victorious. Of the three, Serena has been the biggest star thus far and is the one boasting a Stakes Final on her resume with a runner-up finish in the Hollywoodian earlier this year. There is still more box breaking ability with **LENNOX TO WIN (1)** and **SHAMUS SHEA (8)**. Both possess the speed, ability, and also the coveted post to take tonight's crown. What is left after the speedballs bust out of the box? That would be the three late fliers, and when you can't spot them early don't assume they are finished. **GATOR JOHN (2)** uses a backstretch move that has left many front-runners in the dust. **UP AND CRYIN (3)** quietly stalks and drives. And last but not least, formerly from Naples-Fort Myers, the appropriately named **KIOWA WILLBELATE (6)** will be going into overdrive late as all eight pups fly for the finish.

Race 4 - TRI-STATE CASINO & RESORT - 550 Yards

This year Tri-State may see the winner coming from the middle or back of the original pack, as **QUICK MCRUNFAST (1)** seems to prefer the climactic ending in most of his races. As one of the track's best breakers **JAX MANNY (2)** should set the pace out of the box. **ALI'S TURTLE (3)** and **BLAZE N TODDIE (4)** are also capable of leaving the rest of the field in dust as Turtle has won four of her last seven starts and Toddie has won five of his last seven. **FLYING HOGAN (5)** and **RG'S PARTYBOY (6)** will add some excitement near the end being the only other closers in the race. Also trying to cruise into the Winners Circle will be the top dog at Tri-State this year **CRUISEN COCO (7)**, she also sports 5 wins in her last 7 starts. **LIGHTNING LOBO (8)** is another contender that can take the early lead and not look back. Starting from the outside it wouldn't be surprising to see Lobo take the win. This year could be over from the beginning or it could end in a photo with a come from behind victory.

Race 5 - VICTORYLAND - 550 Yards

Last year's track champion, **CRY KUBOTA (1)** draws the favorable rail post and looks to return to his winning form. **WWW LAZY RIVER (2)** an up and comer who has nine wins for the season. **TRENT VANQUISHER (3)** has been on a roll of late winning four of his last six efforts. **SLATEX CADILLAC (4)** running for the white hot Rhodes Kennel this little lady has reeled off impressive back to back wins. Perhaps the sharpest hound in the field is **KB'S MUSTANG (5)**. This female from the Florio Kennel has been a star at Victoryland since arriving from Mardi Gras, winning 5 in a row and never finishing out of the money in twelve starts. **BF FLYING STAN (6)** is a stake winner and recent World Classic participant and looks as sharp as ever since returning from Florida. **STARZ MY MOMENT (7)** was on a roll winning 5 in a row until a couple of troubled trips set him back. He just missed in his last effort and is 11 for 15 in the quinella. Outside is **SE'S WIRED (8)**. This speedster likes the outside post nad has to be considered as he rarely misses the paysheet.

Race 6 - DERBY LANE - 550 Yards

Tonight's Derby Lane feature is what Night of Stars is all about featuring our headliners. **CELTIC DREAM(1)** is the only female in the field and will have her work cut out for her against her strong speedy rivals. **ALAN GREEN(2)** almost always takes advantage of an inside post. He is favorably posted, but equally matched in speed is **M'S FREE HAND(3)** breaking next to him. The two will battle for the front that might give **KIOWA CLASS KING(4)** a shot at finding room to run. KING is a late breaker who will be looking to close the gap at the end. **SPECIAL PURPOSE(5)** will have to race pretty special in order to beat the impressive speed merchants as well as the dual distance dynamo **FLYING COAL CITY (6)** who will no doubt be a betting favorite has drawn the six for a third consecutive start. Known to fans as the COAL TRAIN the male holds the fastest times over both 550 and 660 and has won two 550 stakes this year. **AERIAL BATTLE (7)** is the current win leader. He won the Matinee Idol and was the runner-up to COAL in the Sprint Classic. BATTLE scores from any post. **KIOWA LAZY LAZY(8)** held the season's best 550-yd. time last year. His eight-length victory in 30.29 last start was the fastest of the night.

Race 7 - GULF GREYHOUND - 550 Yards

Here are the contestants for the \$50,000 Texas Round Up Sprint Championship. **GABLE TERESA (1)** earned her way into the finals with a box to wire win and is sitting pretty on the rail. **BEE'S A WINNER (2)** won two qualifying rounds and has the speed to take it all. **DECO BULL RUM (3)** is loving the state of Texas and his last win shows he's ready for the finals. **CRY HOMER (4)** should stalk the frontrunners and threaten late in the race. **C YA TOM COLLINS (5)** must be considered with his early speed and can overcome the post position. **ATASCOCITA VITO (6)** won two qualifying rounds and drew a perfect spot for his wide driving style. **LOOK MY WAY (7)** earned the most points during the qualifying rounds and is running in peak form at the right time. **NINA'S WAGSTER (8)** can not be overlooked from the outside and his speed can surprise the field.

Race 8 - PALM BEACH - 545 Yards

Racing fans across the country will be keying in on a foursome of these exceptional athletes. **WHERE'S WISE GUY (8)** appears to be the one the other seven entries will be trying to catch. He has finished in the Trifecta his last 7 times at bat and is one tough cookie to run down. One competitor that has a good shot at defeating the Wise Guy is **FLYING CLARET (4)**. This stake finalist is tied for the fastest time run on the 545-yard Royal Palm Course last season, 29.28 seconds. Having drawn in between the slow breaking, but powerful finishing, **ATASCOCITA PINZ (3)** and **CRAZY FOR MADDIE (5)** is a definite plus. And who are these other superstars who has the talent to pull off a Night of Stars victory? Well you can't leave out the explosive **YAHOO RADER (2)** who shares last season's best clocking of 29.28 with Flying Claret. Rader has won four of his last outings in impressive fashion. And one cannot ignore the recent Phoenix rising of **MRL GREEN LIGHT (8)** who has won her last five competitive events. Rounding out this exclusive field is **SAN TAN BULLWHIP (1)** who loves to race the inside and **STELLA BLUE (6)**, the youngest entry who has already scored 10 career victories in only 18 life time starts.

Race 9 - PALM BEACH KENNEL CLUB - 660 Yards

Without a doubt, the Greyhound who is on quite the roll is **MULTIPLE WINS (3)**. She has finished in the Quiniela in 6 of her last 7 middle-distance outings and is very stubborn in giving up any ground. Vying for early supremacy will be the youngster **MIDNIGHT RAMBLER (2)** who has already served up an impressive career Three-Eighths Mile Course record of 9-5-0-2-0. Sitting pretty is **SUPER C KISS (1)**. With a lot of athletes preferring to race the oval mid-track to wide, this pretty young lady will have ample racing room to apply her trade. Making an appearance in the second wave of Greyhounds to enter the frontstretch, will be **ATASCOCITA MABEL (5)**, a relative newcomer to the route who is improving with each and every start. Also keep a keen eye on **SUMWYSE (8)** who will have an advantage, post-position wise, starting the race next to the slow breaking, yet powerful finishing, **CALIF EDGAR (7)**. Perhaps also possibly benefitting from the late-starting Edgar is **WTD NO DOUBT (6)** who can hold her own against the best of them. And then you have the ultimate late-speed bomb in the race, **KIOWA BONITA BET (4)** who has the ability and talent to pass any and all of the entries in this very exciting Night of Stars event!

Race 10 - SOUTHLAND - 703 Yards

Early speed, mixed with a good bit of stamina is required here. **I DO WHAT I WANT (1)** will have her first start against the big boys and girls here and should figure with the favorable post. **BEMMIE (2)** prefers the outside, but if he can manage to avoid any trouble should make his late run down the stretch to challenge. **HEYTHERE DELILAH (3)** is the salty veteran of the group, she can contend from any post on any day. **FTK FOXBORO (4)** ran a great race in her first start at this distance, if she breaks out on top may be tough to catch. **BELLA CHAITIN (5)** struggled a bit in his last start after some early trouble, could be a factor late if he can avoid the traffic. **STARZ RAINY DAY (6)** prefers the inside, but can finish in the money from here as well. **ALICIA KEYS (7)** with her late speed from the outside post, could be the sleeper in this field. **WW MACHO STICK (8)** needs to get to the rail early to figure in this race from this outside post.

Race 11 - SOUTHLAND - 583 Yards

Southland's 55K Sprint Derby, This is truly anyone's race. **SILVER IDOL (1)**, the first of four finalists from the Charter Kennel, in the inside post is exactly where she wants to be. **Trougelz (2)** will force the pace to the first turn, if he gets there first may be tough to catch. **YAHOO OMAR (3)** has drawn his first inside post during this competition. If he clears traffic through the first turn, watch out down the stretch. **DJAYS OCTANE (4)** is the true closer in this field. He'll hit his top gear heading into the far turn. **SUPER STANG (5)** Midtrack greyhound in the center post, he'll be up front from the break, but may not have enough down the stretch in this field. **CT BUCK WILD (6)** if she can avoid the squeeze from the outside, look for her to take the lead and never look back. **BLAZING ALEX (7)** this greyhound has the late kick to upset this field, don't be surprised down the stretch if he steals the win. **JOHNNYATTHE RAIL (8)** This greyhound can challenge from anywhere, can the youngest in the field best the crafty veterans? You bet!

Race 12 - WHEELING DOWNS - 548 Yards

The Wheeling NOS field is loaded with early speed, but don't count out the two big closers in this race. **KELSOS ROCKAWAY (1)** possesses a powerful finish and will be one of the favorites. The track's co-win leader prefers midtrack, but should have room on the rail. **HI NOON HERO (2)** has had trouble from inside boxes at times, but only needs room and a clean trip and he'll be a factor coming home. **TOPAZ ALYANN (3)** has a huge rush to the turn but her success has come from outside posts. **DAKOTAS ALENE (4)** is the youngest dog in the field and may be overmatched despite her big rush to the turn. **KB'S NANTUCKET (5)** needs the front early and has the box speed to take the early lead if he pops it. **KB'S RUCKUS (6)** won the Panhandle Classic in mid-June but prefers an inside box although he won from the seven hole last time out. **FLYING BURGUNDY (7)** can break from any box. She's the most consistent racer in the field with quiniela finishes in her last six starts. **KIOWA LEE PHILLI (8)** has been off her game lately, but the frontrunner is still tied for the top spot in wins.

Race 13 - ORANGE PARK - 770 Yards

This 770 yard race is open season for whomever wants to take it. **STARLA VINTAGE (4)** has breeding on her side and a back to back win streak in tow. This DQ runner should love most distance. **KELSOS HENCHMAN (6)** has been a closing machine over 660 since coming back from the puppy stakes and should feel at home over 770. **KIOWA UNNAT (1)** is a solid rail runner that gets the red box in this effort. She might not be able to hold on late, but ideal spot gets her a look.

GABE CANDICE (5) is a streaky runner that can come on with the best of them in the stretch. If she gets loose, everyone watch out. **KIOWA TRENT TAM (8)** has been running tough at 660, but the extra distance might be a hurdle for him. If he can steal a lead, you never know. **LADY GATOR (7)** is tough on the lead, but has to get there in this race to be effective. If she does break, she might be the surprise winner. **MISS MINERVA (3)** might look a bit overmatched tonight, but she can close late over 660 and might be well suited for this distance. **MB SEE YOU LATER (2)** is a recent ship in and the only greyhound showing a 770 line. Here she must break in order to have a chance to factor.

Race 14 - ORANGE PARK - 550 Yards

All-American hopeful and back to back stakes winner **RS LIBBY LU (1)** has to be the one to beat here. She has won 4 straight from this post and always shows up on game day. On the lead, she is tough to beat. **PADDY WHACKER (2)** prefers the outside, but has the best raw speed in the bunch. From the lead or from behind, he is a threat. **PLAYING AMY SONG (3)** is a strong closer that can make up ground on anyone over 550, but she needs to be close early to win. No matter the lead, don't count her out. **RAIDERS BART (5)** has been hot as of late with 3 wins in 5 races. Breaking is his key to success and he will need a ton early against this talented field. **KIOWA SHAG ALONG (7)** is a cagey veteran with a ton of early speed. Holding on to win has been his weakness in the past. If he breaks, he has a shot tonight. **GM'S CASHMAN (4)** has been really close in all of his recent races. With 2 wins and 6 trifectas in a row, he could be a major force again in this one. **LEADING STEPS (6)** has some speed to burn to the turn and is a force when he can get his nose in front in any race. Holding on at the finish line might be another story though in this effort. **BH'S SIMPLYLEGIT (8)** is riding high off a win in her last effort. Breaking is how she makes her money, so she needs to come out running tonight.

Race 15 - BIRMINGHAM - 550 Yards

From the lead or from behind **POTRS STRIKEOUT (1)** has to be considered a threat to win, especially from the rail post. If he is close early, it will all be over at the wire. **ASU END ZONE (2)** will be trying to use her late speed to score the touchdown tonight. A recent shipper she has won 7 of her 10 starts. **TWEEDLE DUM (3)** has that never give up attitude that sees him picking up people for fun in the stretch. He should give a big late charge again from a great inside post. **OKIE WINDSTAR (4)** is the ankle burner in this race that can come up short in the deep stretch. No doubt who will be in the lead, but holding it might be another story. **JACKIE DAVIS (5)** might not be in the party early on, but this late arriver will make it quite interesting late even from a tough 5 box. **COACH QUALITY (6)** is a solid rusher to the turn that has been on a tear recently. All he has to do is stick to the game plan and he will contend again tonight. **CTW BRIE HEART (7)** is tough as long as she can get close to the early lead, so a big break is needed for her in this effort if she wants to challenge. **MAC'S HAPPY (8)** is as fast as he wants to be. He can challenge from the lead, or from behind, but winning has escaped him as of late. Tonight he could break out of the slump.

Race 16 - TUCSON - 550 Yards

RAMS DIXIE LYNN (1) might prefer the outside, but has shown she can run from the rail too. With a solid break and that closing speed, she might be tough to beat here. **BOC'S MARTINI (2)** is a solid competitor that can surprise and steal away a win on occasion. From a great post, tonight might be the night. **BELLA NINA (3)** has some good early speed, but will need room early on to use it. If she can get clear, she could be a big force. **TOKEN WHITE (4)** is in against a tough field and really needs to bring her A game to this effort. If she wants to break and run, she might have a shot. **GAME PLAN (5)** is clearly the greyhound to beat in this race. She has won 5 in a row and has come from downtown to get it done. Tonight, another thrilling finish. **CURIOUS ALGY (6)** has some good early speed and should be a major force throughout in this effort. Overcoming this post could be his biggest hurdle. **SLATEX BREAKAWAY (7)** must get out in a hurry in this race and use his early speed to get him into contention. He is short late and that could cost him in the stretch. **RC LANIE (8)** has shown some good late speed in the past and despite a couple of rough efforts, he looks to rebound and show off his closing form in this race.
