



Race Previews

Race 1: RAYNHAM-TAUNTON

What a lineup we have in store for the opener in Night Of Stars XII. A solid mixture of talented veterans, and impressive newcomers will compete over the 5/16th sprint distance. **ICU FERRIS** (3) has 23 wins in 49 lifetime starts and if given room, figures to be the one to beat. **KELSOS RECOURSE** (2) has yet to reach her second birthday and has already proven to be one of the best greyhounds at the track winning 8 of her 13 outings. **PAT C CAIRNS** (1) is in top form having won three in succession and drawing post position #1 will give this four year old a legitimate chance. **JIMBO COBBLEPOT** (4) has impressed since his arrival from Lincoln Greyhound Park with 6 wins in 7 starts (4 Schooling). While **EXPRESS SAMPSON** (5) will look to explode from the box with his good early speed, Sampson has hit the board in 10 of his last 12 starts. **M'S LIKE A ROCK** (8) has blazing early speed and must somehow find a way to seize the early lead while **FUZZYS BLACKJACK** (6) has impressed after a one month layoff and **EARL** (7) figures to come off the pace.

Race 2: WONDERLAND

Focus on tonight's Night of Stars Race will surely be on the ageing warrior **SR'S TOOLMAN** (1), looking for career win number 80 and the title of champion to add to his impressive record. The betting favorite should be **ORKIN** (3) the Revere Course win leader this year hoping to continue North Shore's winning streak in this event. Litter mate to Orkin, **ZAKITA** (6) shows two recent course wins and the 13 wins over the oval speaks for itself. **KELSOS DESIREE** (2) strong showing Sunday night over a talented field

draws a nice position and will definitely be a factor. Another favorable post draw for **BABY FACE BANDIT** (8), with the wide speed and 2 wins in a row. Peaking at just the right time, she will be looking for the upset. The chasing **SHO NUFF GIT IT** (1), draws the coveted one box and is always a money factor. **HATH NO FURY** (7) has 27 in the money finishes in 48 starts this year. Although the last 2 starts might look a little disappointing he has the speed to get to the front and could look to benefit from any early trouble. Sleeper **MILO BEE** (5), needs to break strongly and establish a huge lead to hold off these.

Race 3: SEABROOK

High early speed is the common denominator in tonight's contest. **RHODYS TIME**(1) A rising star who has climbed from maiden to Gr. A in his first 4 starts. He exhibits a big rushing style and must take the benefit to be a factor. **FLY BABY STINKER**(2) Has made the front 7 of his last 8 starts with 6 victories. He has high early foot and on the lead should prove dominant. **DUTCH REVA**(3) She's one of the most consistent racers at the speedy Seabrook oval this meet. Must make the lead to prevail. **CLB BLONDIE**(4) The top sprinter in the field with 18 wins. She can fly from on or off the pace. **REMEMBER GENO**(5) a solid campaigner who sports a 13 out of 16 in the money finishes. She needs a little racing luck to upset this stellar field. **BADGER OLIVE OIL**(6) A seasoned veteran who will try to parlay her speed and experience into the win. **ASHA**(7) This youngster displays a versatile running style that should suit him well. A consistent pup with a perfect 9 out of 9 in the money finishes. **SAFARI BUCK SHOT**(8) A competitive hound who is well placed here in the outside post position.

Race 4: NAPLES - FT. MEYERS

DOUBLECROSS(1) senior member of this field, last season's track win leader and 2003 3/8ths Derby champ, has posted 65 career wins. **FANCY THAT**(2) steady performer who likes the outside, needs to revert to form that saw her win 5 in a row earlier this year. **LADY DAWG DRIVE**(3) up and coming star was hurt as a pup but has made up for it by winning 6 out of 7 lifetime starts with her early rushes to the turn. **PATRICK MARTIN**(4) nearly unbeatable this season with 14 wins in 17 starts, uses great early speed to dominate and is the only greyhound in this field to break the 30 second plateau this season. **RS DODGE DESTINY**(5) youngest member of the field, climbed the grading ladder with ease and has shown good late kick with 4 come from behind victories. **ONECO DERRINGER**(6) winner of 8 out of his last 12 starts, had two 2nd and one 3rd in Seabrook Great Race stakes earlier this year. **GR'S UNLUCKY**(7) best closer in tonight's field, likes the outside and has gotten better with each start. **SWITZLER MACOMB**(8) looked very impressive his last start, seems to be back in top form after being plagued by injuries, he's a wide runner and should fare well from the outside post position.

Race 5: BIRMINGHAM

MARGARITA BABE(1) had a month off from 08/08/03 till 09/16/03 and is returning to form needs mid track. **LANDSLIDER**(2) has good speed to first turn on a win streak of five in a row will be a favorite. **RG'S WHISKAWAY**(3) Night of Stars winner 11/02/02 always a betting favorite with fans hard to beat if leading at first turn. **HEY BARANUS**(4) mid track

runner capable early speed. **LD'S BAHAMA**(5) five years old and Birmingham all time win leader with 105 all his races have been run at Birmingham 249 starts 237 times in the money will give his all every out Night of Stars winner 05/10/03. **BD'S HANNIBAL**(6) capable good close mid track runner 50% wins 44 starts 22 wins. **TULIN DESTINY**(7) gives good effort every out capable late drive runs inside and out. **VALID TEN POT**(8) Gr. AA at Tri-State before coming to Birmingham a definite threat to hit the board.

Race 6: DAIRYLAND

KALLIE VALLIE (7) should be the talk of NOS XII. In her last four starts, she won the Dairyland Futurity stakes and reset her own track record in Futurity qualifying. She is heading into tonight's sixth race looking to capture her eighth straight victory. The wild card in this race is **BOHEMIAN GRASP** (4). She just tallied her sixth straight with a 57.1% season win record over VALLIE's 33.9%. **BOHEMIAN GRASP** is second best on the season with 28 wins; however, VALLIE has truly come on to her own, breaking the 5/16th mile track record twice since August and scoring 35% of her wins this season in her last seven starts. The two haven't seen head-to-head competition since August. KALLIE VALLIE's recent success comes from her ability to be first on the break. **KAHOOTS** (1), **THERE'S SLAMMER** (3) and **BARJAY GIRL** (5) are the top contenders to fill out the Trifecta and Superfecta. As of lately, SLAMMER is the most consistent of the three, but KAHOOOTS' post suits him the best. **TOMMY ROMANO** (8), winner of NOS X, is making his fourth straight NOS start. Tonight's sixth race... It's all about the break and it's all about speed.

Race 7: TRI-STATE

X'S GREEN HORNET (1) has had 50 starts in grade AA in this 2003 season with 11 wins and 17 seconds. **CLEO N TOOTER** (2) is always a bettor's favorite with consistently finishing in win place and show in 30 of his 39 starts in AA. **CTW MISS KELLY** (3) went from maiden to AA in 10 starts and has remind a strong AA since. **JIMBO ACORN** (4) 5/16 record holder with a 29.78 is back in AA and ready to regain its winning ways. **GENIUS PEPPER** (5) is always a favorite to be in the money by hitting the board 33 out of its last 44 starts. **UMR SWEET TOOTH** (6) is the top sprinter in 2003 with 33 wins out of 45 starts at tri-state. **EF CAJUN NICKY** (7) is the youngest of the group and getting better every race. **SOLITARY CENT** (8) with 18 wins and 14 seconds in 54 starts this is a sprinter that knows how to win.

Race 8: PALM BEACH

Track Champion **DV's MIDNIGHT** (3) posted more victories this year than the Detroit Tigers. However, even a "Yankees" like champ can be beat. Just ask **HEY JUDGE BUD** (5) & **PAT C T BONE** (7) who pulled off the "Marlins" like miracle chasing down the champ in recent weeks. **MOANIN LISA** (8) ran fourth in last year's \$300,000 GAGF at the Woodland's and third in the final leg of the Big Three at Palm Beach this year. She's the only pure speed of the race and can go coast to coast. Like Father like son, **REDLINE FANTASY** (6) has blossomed late and is one tough gal on the lead. She times the break with perfection and may never look back. If that's too chalky and you like a little bang for your buck,

here are a few that fit the bill. **B MAC'S FATIMA** (1) has been a super friend hitting the board 85 of 105 tries and will be flying late. **TNT RUSH UP** (4) beat Hey Judge Bud in the \$25,000 Puppy Stakes, it could be bombs away if he gets clear on the rail. **DYNAMIC PHILLIP** (2) will try to wrestle the lead away from Lisa and leave any traffic in his wake.

Race 9: ORANGE PARK

ROOFTOP RE ANNE (1) has been in the superfecta in eight races in a row. She's won two of her last four races from this post. **LET'S PLAY FAIR** (2) has competed in twenty-seven races in 3/8ths and has finished in the superfecta nineteen times. **JD'S SUNSET GIFT** (3) is a good early speed greyhound. Over her last twenty-five races she has finished out of the superfecta four times. **TASK DOWN DRAFT** (4) loves to race midtrack and should feel right at home from the 4 box, as he has only finished out of the trifecta once in his nine races from this post position. **DAVE'S LOVERGIRL** (5) is a good closer in 3/8ths and has been running very well with nine efforts in a row in the superfecta, including two wins in her last three starts. **TMC'S TIMELESS** (6) is a good closer at the 3/8ths and likes to race outside. She has finished second in three of her last five starts. **BUNNY'S WHAMMO** (7) is a puppy that has taken to 3/8ths with three superfecta efforts in her first four races. **BURT ROAD** (8) is currently the national win leader who had won 9 races in a row. He started a new streak last time out with a 5 length victory where he set the meets best time for the third time in thirteen races at 37.39 seconds.

Race 10: TAMPA

It would be a special pup included with the likes of this quality field and **SIMITAR** (1) fits the bill. The youngest of the field won over established racers last Saturday. **CLAPPIN THUNDER** (2) a solid grade contender since last year should storm his way to the front and the rail for a money finish. **ODD ROMONA** (3) one of two Raines' entries held the season's fastest distance time last year and this year's sprint record speaks for itself. **FLYING CHANG** (4) will look for the rail as soon as he can get there. He boasts 24 out of 27 money finishes, but is unfavorably posted. **CAYMAN WENT** (5) is a well-established dual distance contender that moved back to sprints last week. Already a double-sprint stakes winner he looks to break close to the leaders where he has speed to spare at the end. **ODD BLOSSOM** (6) was 23 out of 27 in the money last year and will need to get out early to factor in the field. **FUZZYS CANNON** (7) the track wins leader is also in contention for the national title. He is a powerful runner expected to be the betting favorite. **ROOFTOP MOBY** (8) courses his third start back from a stakes win in Kansas where he was undefeated. He won nine consecutive races from outside posts earlier this year.

Race 11: WHEELING

With five wins in six starts **BELLE'S DOYLE** (7) seems to be the hot contender in this field. His last win came from the same post and looks to stretch his winning streak to four tonight. With only 11 starts, this hot pup has only missed the pay sheet twice. Watch out for **SLATEX STRIKER** (1) winning on an

off track and holding off a late charge from **WW APPLE JAX** (5) in their last. Earlier he ran a win streak of four straight. **CRY AMY** (2), **E'S POWER GLIDE** (3) and WW APPLE JAX have been hitting the board pretty consistently and look at them to factor into the Trifecta and Superfecta. If a victory is come from off the pace, WW APPLE JAX has been charging the front end in the stretch and could have enough to get back into his winning ways.

Race 12: BLUFFS RUN

RR SALTY DAWG (1) finished 2nd in the Semi- and Quarter. It is imperative for Dawg to bust the box and avoid any trouble that may occur in the first turn. **DASH FOR DAYLITE** (2) If Daylite is coming from the inside, then the rest of the field may be running for 2nd place. 2 starts from the #1 post in the qualifying and 2 wins. **RR BALANCING ACT** (3) dominated in the 2nd round and won by 3, but with stiffer competition, she only won by a head in the quarters. **PK'S WIGGLE** (4) has lit the board from the 2nd round through the semis but just couldn't come up with the win. **PK'S KING LOUIE** (5) Be wary of that 6th place finish in the Semis but don't let it scare you away...bad break. This greyhound is one of the few who can come from off the pace and steal the win. **ALIKAR** (6) is another one that must have the ability to pop the box and get out in front before they reach the first turn. **LIMITED OUT** (7) only won his first round race and that was only by a nose. If he runs into any type of trouble in the first turn, he may back off and try to charge late. **SLATEX SUSAN** (8) will need to establish a sizeable lead as they round for home as she could run out of steam down the stretch.

Race 13: FLAGLER

Run over 1940 foot Flagler Course, the Night of Stars from Flagler is shaping up as a showdown of puppies that broke their maidens this season. Half of tonight's field consists of greyhounds with thirty or less career starts, all of them making a name for themselves from the moment they set foot of the racing oval. **MOONLIGHTER** (1), **AH'S FLASH** (2), **LASS BONNIE** (4), and **JIMBO FLYING B** (7) will be out to prove that experience is not nearly as important as youthful speed. Based on her current streak of seventeen straight "in the money" finishes, Moonlighter should be the people's choice tonight and wearing the red blanket certainly won't hinder a "Star" effort for this youngster from the Marriott Kennel. The experienced half of the tonight's field will be led by **SLOTMACHINEQUEEN** (3). With twelve wins this season this Haber Kennel entry has found the winner's circle more than anyone in tonight's race. Combined with a better than 50% quiniela record, Slotmachinequeen poses a formidable combination of experience and talent when compared to the pups. Filling out the field, but not to be ignored, are **NIMBY VICTORIA** (5), **MY NIECE SHANNON** (6), and **PIKES JEFFERSON** (8), the latter sitting pretty on the outside.

Race 14: GULF GREYHOUND

A'S RED ROVER(1) is one of two hard chargers in the field and is coming off a big win last outing. **GJ'S OBE KENOBE**(2) has been a solid competitor all year long but can he handle the big boys? **HH BADGER BLAZE**(3) is consistently in the money and 5th

on the win list this year. **GABLE HUMVEE**(4), since breaking his maiden just 14 starts ago, proves he is one of the best up-and-comers at the track and will contend heavily in this race. **BE DISCRETE**(5) comes in as last years defending Track Champion and this years Wins Leader (30). He is the sharpest breaker at the track and will show-off for the country on the front-end. This greyhound is an instant GGP Hall-of-Famer. **SHADOW OFA DOUBT**(6) won the Texas Fall Sprint last Saturday and has taken the track by storm since coming back from a severe injury late in 2002. He has 25 wins in 29 starts this year and holds the fastest time, 30.13, of anybody in the race. He is the one to beat in this contest. **BARN DANCE**(7) is the other big closer in the race and will come flying at the end. He has been hot lately and with trouble ahead, could surprise the field. **SEEGOLD MARLIN**(8) is a solid youngster that shows good early speed and will need it with this bunch.

Race 15: **SOUTHLAND**

TBO'S RANDY (1) Definitely carries favorite status going in. Won the richest stakes event of the season the \$50,000 Southland Derby in July and is co-win leader with 26. **BB's HOT TABASCO** (2) is a dominant sprint rail runner with nineteen wins and thirty-four quiniela finishes in only sixty starts. Won the \$10,000 Hartwell Summer Juvenile in June. **LOBO SALUTE** (3) won \$10,000 Winter Juvenile in December 2002 and since then a hard trying sprinter and co-win leader with 26 victories for 2003. **JC's RED DAWN** (4) is an exceptional sprint runner who improved steadily in the last few weeks collecting four wins and three seconds in her last eight starts. **OKIE MALLIE** (5) is one of many strong young pups coming of age at Southland. Rail runner figures to be close on pace in any sprint start. **GLENGAR SON** (6) has mushroomed into one of Southland's best. Has fastest time over Arkansas Course with a blistering 31.63. Hails from St. Pete where he was a strong closing sprinter. **GOODBYE JESSICA** (7) is a young proven juvenile who has logged plenty of times well under the thirty-two second barrier. The breaker-stayer prefers the rail. **HURRY HOME** (8) was a semi-finalist in the \$50,000 Sprint Derby. Won five straight sprint 583 races from 8-28 thru 9-13. Runs best from mid to outside.

Race 16: **PHOENIX**

PGP's Night of Stars finale features some swift, front running distance runners, but the greyhound to beat is 2003 Phoenix Derby runner-up **KARON R LOVE**

(1). She has been running well from very difficult post positions, and she has the firepower to come and get likely early leader **CALL ME ALIBI** (4), a speedy rookie who has only recently turned her attention to the 685 yard course. Also hard to leave off your ticket is **COLDWATER HELEN** (2), a veteran sprinter/distance runner who has been competing against PGP's best in the 2003 Distance Countdown. Among the greyhounds with a chance to surprise is 770 yard track record holder **COLORMEIMPRESSED** (3), but this inside runner usually needs the early lead to be at her best. 2003 Derby finalist **WW ROYAL COURT** (8) will slash to the rail early and needs a lightning quick start to light the board. **KAY SKY DIVER** (5) is a rocket when cut loose early, but the quickness of **CALL ME ALIBI** (4) may foil her chances to upset the field. **HI TECH MATTIE** (7) and **BC DILL MARY** (6) race midtrack, but both seem likely to be lost in the shuffle early.
