



Race Previews

Naples- Ft. Myers - 660 yds.

DL'S MARTINA(1) has made the finals of the 660 Hurricane Stakes. She will need to get out early to contend with this field. **SUNSANDS PERKY(2)** will force the pace early. Her style is early speed and "Catch me if you can!" Our 2005 Hurricane Stakes Champion, **BD GOLDEN GIRL(3)** loves the 660 yard distance and will be the greyhound to beat. 28 of her 29 wins come from the 660 box. **PENROSE VERTEX(4)** is beginning to come into form. He is an off & gone runner and will need a perfect trip to hold off these rivals. In her short career here, **GO CRITTER GO(5)** is a very wide runner. She will use the outside path to get it done and close up ground. Track favorite, **SMALL BUT SWEET(6)** will be dropping down from her usual 770 box for this race. She will have to fire a bit earlier to get around her rivals. **EBRO BETTY SUE(7)** will have to stay close to the field to have a chance at an upset. Her wide running style may be her only draw back. **BART'S KALI(8)** is ideally posted on the outside. She will try and beat this field with her steady running style.

Seabrook - 550 yds.

High early speed is the common denominator in tonight's contest. **KNP MOMA'S MABLE(1)** She's a hard hitting campaigner who is well positioned here on the rail. Has closing ability and could benefit for the win. **SAV'S CAJUNQUEEN(2)** A seasoned veteran who will try to parlay her speed and experience into the win. **LR'S PRISCILLA(3)** The top sprinter in the field with 10 wins this meet. She has high early speed and the ability to go box to wire. **CUVETTA(4)** Relies on her quick early foot and must be on the lead to be a factor. **QWIKASAHOBONHAM(5)** Winner of 29 of his last 48. This dominant closer sets the stage for a torrid late rally. **TS SILVER BULLET(6)** A rising star who's won 5 of his last 7 races. Has great rush speed and on the lead and could prove dominant. **HK'S SANDRA(7)** needs a little luck to upset this field. **UMR LESLIE LOU(8)** The youngest racer in the sprint dis-

plays a versatile racing style that suits her well from the outside post position.

Bluffs Run - 550 yds.

RUB N TUG(1) comes into tonight's race having won his last start by a neck. He may need to catch a big break to light the board. **BARTS BOSANOVA(2)** has won 4 out of his last 7 races at Bluffs Run. Coming off a big win on April 23rd by 10 lengths. **SLATEX FLARE(3)** had an unfortunate race on Tuesday but can do well if he can break on top and build a lead. **BD'S SHADOW(4)** has won his last 3 races but only 2 of which have been in grade A. Shows a strong desire to close strong at the end. **RB MISTLETOE JO(5)** is the only female, but looks to be the class of this field. **IM READY TO RUN(6)** has run very consistent lately finishing in the money 5 out of his last 7 starts. **MARIAS JOHN(7)** has proven to be very competitive in 2005, finishing in the money 83% of the time. **GIL'S CICERO(8)** has performed well his past few starts and hopefully he'll have enough gas in the tank to hold on at the wire.

Hollywood - 550 yds.

K'S HOT SHOT(1) has reeled off 2 grade A wins in a row. He previously raced at Palm Beach. **JC'S DAWSON(2)** prefers the middle 3/8 distance, very consistent with 27 out of 37 in the money. **WHERE'S STARBUCK(3)** sired by the outstanding greyhound Kiowa Sweet Trey, he had a powerful 6 length win on May 3. **SILENT POWER(4)** won his 100th Career win at Hollywood, came back with 101 in his next start, 5½ years old and still winning against top competition. **REGALL LUXOR(5)** bred by 2 time world classic Champ Ea's Itzaboy. **WW GALE TRADE(6)** was laid off over months after winning the Hollywood Futurity - First start back scored an 8 length victory. **RC'S BRIANA(7)** 17 out of 27 wins - has scored impressive wins at both 5/16 and 3/8. **ONE NATION(8)** has won 4 out of his last 5 starts. He also competed in the World Classic and prefers an inside post.

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Race Previews

Tri-State - 550 yds.

With 7 of our top dogs vs. one NOS veteran, this race should prove to be very electrifying. Look for NOS veteran **PEEK A JIGGLE(5)** to charge to the front at midtrack unless **WV'S INWOOD(3)** flaunts his incredible speed to match his best time of 30.04. If **HB'S NU WAY JAY(8)**, who has won 7 of his last 10, can find the inside lane, watch for him to continue his winning streak. On Nu Way Jay's tail and looking for revenge is **KANSAS SKIPPER(2)**. 2 weeks ago Nu Way Jay nudged out Skipper for a win and he is eager to return the favor. With his quick times Skipper is a definite contender. **SOARIN HIGH(7)** brings the consistency of a champion with a record of 4-3-1 in her last 10 races. She's ready to use this to take her straight to number 1. **TOXIC ROCKET(1)** is an experienced AA racer and could pose a large threat to the field late in the race. Dangerous from any post position and fresh off multiple 1st and 2nd place wins is **MYOKIE FLAME(6)**. Flame shows some impressive lines with steadfast times making her a solid competitor. **GUARDIAN(4)** may try to pull to an early lead down the front stretch and through the first turn. If there's a midtrack bottleneck, Guardian could cruise the inside lane for a close win.

Palm Beach - 545 yds.

OZZIE THE MAN(1) has blazing speed out of the box. He is undefeated out of the #1 box(6 of 6) and very rarely gets caught with the lead. Following Ozzie through the turn will be **MATT'S GULF(8)** and **SHALL WE SEA(3)** both of whom demand the rail on the break, but nonetheless should enter the backstretch trouble free. **CEE BAR YOGI(5)** is racing his career best and with everything in the event racing on the inside, his late midtrack speed could land him a spot in the superfecta. **JS WIN OR GOHOME(4)** has a nice rush to the first turn but will need a quick break to outgun the other early speed entries to the turn. **DON L POWERWAGON(2)** is also racing very strong, having finished in the superfecta his last 10 starts. **JAWADOGTRACKMIKE(6)** and **AHOY JOHN W TROY(7)** will both need a little racing luck to offset the onslaught of speed early in the race

Palm Beach - 660 yds.

Watch our current track win leader and veteran closer of the field **KAYCAR DOROTHY(2)**, who is 30 of 61 in season victories. She breaks well from inside posts and having middle-distance newcomer **GLB'S SOLITAIRE(1)** to her inside and the rusher **ATASCOCITA LEO(3)** to her immediate right could prove to be the right combination for a clean trip around the oval. **MARYVILLE LOOKER(8)** is looking pretty in the outside post and looks to have a trouble free run down the front stretch. **PALM BALL(7)** is also in a good spot and has finished in the super her last 6 races. **TOYBOX DEDEE(4)** will need an extremely swift break, and if she does, could play a factor. **TNT RUSH UP(6)** is well versed on the 660-yard course. He will need to get to the inside and then turn on the afterburners in the backstretch. **PICO EDIES EDDIE(5)** will also need a super break and needs to be out front early to pull off the upset.

Naples-Ft. Myers - 550 yds.

DON L LIL DENTON(1) loves to rush to the front and force the pace. **BK COREY(2)** will be in the pocket around the turn. If the leaders stumble, she will be there to take charge. **CRAIGIE ZITA J(3)** is a young lady that has climbed the ladder quickly. She has found her form but will need a clean trip to compete here. After taking a month off, **SILENT SOLDIER(4)** will try to return to his campaign of winning and conquering his rivals. He loves to rush up and turn on the gas. **ICU ANNIE(5)** will attempt to become Naples first 2 time NOS Champion. Though poorly posted, she will race with all her heart. **MARTY'S HOT DOG(6)** will be the odds on favorite. She has found a groove and is in control of her own destiny. Early speed and "Catch me if you can!" **LASTGAL STANDING(7)** will try to catch them in the stretch for the win. **DRINK UP DALBY(8)** is perfectly posted on the outside. A clean trip for him could spell upset winner. If he gets to the lead he will be tough to beat.

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Race Previews

Derby Lane - 550 yds.

JR'S FLASHY(7) who is known as the "streak buster" is posted well, but will need to outbreak **FUZZYS OKLAHOMA(8)** who will seek the rail after the break, and has a strong finish over this shorter run. **FIREWORK DISPLAY(6)** has dual distance abilities and will be a favorite. Although the #6 post is unfavorable, his record speaks for itself. **WHISTLER'S SEA(2)** reached the top grade in just 6 starts. Of his 33 starts, SEA has drawn the #2 post 4 times where he boasts a 100% win record from here. **BD'S IMOGENE(5)** her 4th place finish last week broke 8 straight quinielas. She is one of the fastest breakers from an unfavorable post. **SILENT LAMBERT(3)** has beaten some of this year's top dogs. The superfecta specialist looks to light the board for 11 consecutive starts tonight. **MAGNIFICENT MIKE(4)** recently moved to the top grade. He may lack experience, but he reeled off 4 wins in his last 6 starts beating some of tonight's contenders. **FLYING PREMIUM(1)** is the youngest. He may not know what to do from the rail post that he has drawn only once, winning grade D.

Orange Park - 550 yds.

BP BANTEM CHEF(1) has won her last 2 race. She's tough when close early on, so a big break is needed tonight. **BLACK ICE(2)** was the winner of NOS XIV at OP and the win leader on the meet. He is an all out front runner with track record speed, and usually is all or nothing in his races. **HOLLAND HATTIE(3)** is a solid in grade A that never gives up. She drew a favorable inside post position and was in the quiniela in 6 races in a row. **DG'S NEMO(4)** finished 4th in the 2004 Orange Park Puppy Stakes. Recently he's won 5 of his last 9 starts, and hasn't missed the superfecta. **JNB GOODTIME GAL(5)** is an all out early speed greyhound. She has 2 wins in a row and will factor early on in this race. **NOT SATISFIEDYET(6)** has 5 wins in his last 6 starts, including one which almost set a new track record. From the front or from behind he can win races. Amongst national win leaders on the year with 16. **WHIRLPOOL(7)** loves running from the outside posts. She has good early foot and has been in the superfecta in 8 of her last 11 starts. **KIOWA GET VIOLET(8)** has never missed the superfecta from here. On the meet she had a run of 8 wins in 10 starts including 5 wins in a row.

Orange Park - 660 yds.

RAPIDO MADERO(1) has won 4 of 5 races from inside of the 4 box. His game is early speed, he factors early on in this race. **ROOFTOP KERNEL(2)** has 4 quinielas and a pair of wins in 8 starts at 660 yards. He runs near the front, so a big break will be needed here. **DARKEST ONYX(3)** is an early speed greyhound that will be competing for the lead. Recently he has 9 trifecta efforts in his last 11 starts, including 4 wins. **CRAIGIE BOUQUET(4)** was the winner of the 2005 Orange Park Derby. She has been struggling with her break, but if she gets out you know what the results will be. **LET'S ROCK IT(5)** is the veteran of this field with almost 200 starts. In her last 17 races she has been in the superfecta 13 times with 5 wins. **LET'S PLAY FAIR(6)** is the best closer here. She made the finals of the Orange Park Derby the last two years, and has not missed the trifecta in 14 straight races. **SOLITARY COBRA(7)** had the hot hand with a run of 4 wins in a row. When he breaks he is a force, but can be caught if they get to him early enough. **PAT C MATCH(8)** has been in the superfecta in 5 of her last 6 races, including a pair of wins. The post suites her well as she hasn't missed the money from here.

Wheeling - 548 yds.

Eight young guns battle in this race and 2004 All-American **GREYS ROYALCROWN(6)** leads the pack as the win leader last season and already has 11 victories this year. 3 greyhounds carry mini win streaks into tonight, as **MOVING PICTURE(3)** has 2 straight and 9 quiniela finishes in 14 starts. **BOONE'S LINKY(7)** also has 2 straight wins by a total of 9 lengths and has won 3 of his last 5. **Young stud ROCK ERA(5)** has compiled one of the best records overall with 7 wins and 15 out of 18 in the superfecta. Speaking of near perfection, **STAT U S EMINEM(4)** has only missed the board once this season, that coming last start(over a different distance). **TEMPO PETROCELLI(1)** has great rush to the turn and it shows going 21 of 24 in the superfecta. The hottest pup around just may be **FANCY RUCKUS(8)**. She won her "AA" debut last start out and carries a 3 race win streak into tonight. If there is trouble in the race, watch out for **BD'S WESLEY(2)**. He doesn't break well, but comes home like a freight train. He has 9 wins this season, 6 of them in top grade.



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Race Previews

Wheeling - 678 yds.

Jack be nimble and Jack be quick, but it's **NIMBY TP JAN(1)** that has the most wins (10) of the field and 3 wins in her last 4 starts. **RN'S SPEED DEMON(4)** will put the pedal to the metal, racking up 3 wins and a 2nd place effort in his first 4 starts at this distance. **OKIE MALLIE(6)** has been known to break quickly and uses that speed well; hitting the trifecta 4 out of her last 5 starts. **BD'S WENDY(2)** is on a roll with her last 4 starts all great efforts including 2 wins. **SMILEY SHIFTY(3)** makes his debut in "AA" against tough competition, but he has hit the trifecta in all 6 of his starts here in this distance. Don't go nuts, but **GLS KOMAKAZI(5)** is a superfecta player's dream as he has appeared on the ticket 10 out of his last 11 starts. Run for cover as **GREYS STORMCLOUD(8)** has only had 4 starts this season on the 678 yard course, but his record is a very nice 4/2-1-0-1. Any win is good, but **ITS GOODNPLENTY(7)** can claim all 5 of his victories over this distance this season, including a 10-length romp back on March 25th.

Gulf - 550 yds.

Anything can happen and probably will, in one of the most evenly drawn NOS races ever at GGP. **GABLE CHLOE(1)** drawing the inside post and leading the pack in wins, will probably be the favorite to win the race. **SAN TAN JACKPOT(7)** goes to post with the ability to blow the field away; however, he'll need a very sharp break to get the job done. **MONTERREY GOTILE(4)** has won his share of big races by using his tremendous late kick. Look for him to come charging home in the stretch. **BIG SHOT(8)** has legitimate early foot and is always tough to the stretch. The question is, can she hold off the pack? **ML'S SWITCHBLADE(2)** runs the 660-yard course a bit better, but has been getting hot lately over the shorter distance. Don't count him out! **GABLE PHIREFLY(3)** has two straight AA wins and possesses ability to hold off late challengers, but in this race, the cavalry may be coming. **AZ TRIPLE H(6)** is a strong breaker and good rusher, but with the classy late speed in the race, he may be overmatched. He must run a perfect race to win. **CASSIES GOT GAME(5)** is a wildcard here. It seems that when you count out this early speedster, he always makes you pay.

Southland - 583 yds.

DAC(1) recently set a new seasons best time of 31.73. The pup can lead the way with his blistering speed or pass you by in the stretch. **DARK N DEE(2)** has reeled off 10 wins in 12, beat DAC's season best time with an awesome 31.69, and is only .08 from matching the all time record. **BRAZIC(3)** has dominating speed early or late and generally holds the lead when he gets it. This will be his first taste of stakes action. **SANTA FE MERLIN(4)** is a solid racer with 16 pay-days in 22 starts. This sprinter needs the rail and the lead to have a shot. **DAVE THE DOG(5)** is our current win leader with 13, has only missed the money 3 times this year. This greyhound is a fan favorite and rarely lets them down. **OKIE CHACO(6)** has 10 starts this season with 8 finishes in the money. He has impressive early speed and jumps out to a quick start. The quicker he starts the better with the fast pace. **FLYING RICHELLE(7)** has only missed payday once this year. Showing late backstretch power, her dominating finish looks to be the youngster's trademark. She prefers the inside route but can overcome midtrack troubles. **JC'S RED DAWN(8)** is a veteran who has no preference of post. She typically brakes slow, then puts it in overdrive to run down her rivals in the stretch.

Cloverleaf - 550 yds.

PAT C BUTTONDOWN(1) drew his favorite number one hole and certainly seems to be set-up perfect to grab the win. He recorded the fastest time of the meet four starts ago and has been in top form since. **RUBY MOON(6)** only has eight starts this meet but, she shows some amazing speed and could easily grab the lead early and not look back. **WPS DADDYFRANKS(4)** has the longest win streak coming into tonight's race and also leads the field with ten wins on the meet. **CB JAKE SNAKE(8)** bad draw in getting the eight hole so, he will have to use his early speed to get the lead and the rail early. **PB'S RIPPEN GOLD(3)** will have to use he late kick to gain on field but, maybe to far off the pace to catch the early leaders. **DADDY WARBUCKS(5)** the youngest greyhound in the field tonight but, has a good chance to be among the leaders. **GLO'S RED GRANGE(7)** steady early speed greyhound who should factor somewhere on the ticket. **SWEET HOPE(2)** will probably go off as the long-shot and will need a lot of luck to finish on top.



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Race Previews

Phoenix - 550 yds.

Tonight's Night of Stars program concludes with another stellar cast of sprinters from Phoenix Greyhound Park. **BELLA FINANCE(1)** hugs the rail, never runs a bad race, and looks great in red. 2005 rookie **CLOSE BY(2)**, barrels from off the pace and is already an expert at weaving his way through traffic. **MY BLONDE HONEY(3)** was our 2004 track champ and continues to race in primetime form. **GREYS TOLL GATE(4)** stormed from off the pace to win our 2005 Sprint Stake and is the current win leader at PGP. **MOON MT DIPPER(5)**, who recently returned to action after suffering a toe injury, won our 2004 Juvenile Stake, began her career with 12 consecutive victories, and is impossible to catch once she shakes loose early. **CUTTIN DA CLOCK(6)** runs well from the outside, and although he has been in top form lately, may find himself caught in a squeeze play early. Box-busting, speed demon **RJ'S SUSAN B(7)** has never been better and she has been spectacular in recent competition in the 2005 Kennel Challenge series. **COLDWATER SHARLA(8)** is a rail slashing, early speed specialist who will need a lightning-quick start to avoid early contact with one or more of her rivals tonight.
